Model 1 – trade in bovine animals

- *Box reference I.31.:*

Official identification: Indicate the unique identification code from the visible means of identification applied to each animal forming the consignment which is the official identification of the animal in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1760/2000 of the European Parliament and of the Council. The characters forming the identification code shall comprise of two-letter country code followed by no more than 12 numeric digits as referred to in Article 1(2) of Regulation (EC) No 911/2004. This field is optional.

Number of passport ~~or temporary passport~~: Indicate the number(s) of the passport(s) or, if authorised by the competent authority, the temporary passport(s) for animals less than 4 weeks old, as provided for in Article 6(2) of Regulation (EC) No 911/2004, issued for the animals forming the consignment.

- *Box reference I.31.:*

Official identification: The animals shall be identified in accordance with Council Directive 2008/71/EC.

Birth date: (dd/mm/yyyy). This field is optional.

~~Sex: (M = male, F = female, C = castrated).~~

Age of pigs:

- 1. pigs of less than three weeks shall not be considered fit for transport – Chapter I(2)(e) of Annex I to Regulation No 1/2005; the rest conditions are referred in relation to weight of pigs;*
- 2. previous version of Annex F to Directive 64/432/EEC*
