State of play of the procedure

Situation on 8 May 2020

- In the 1st phase of discussions with national experts on:
 - Possible relaxations
 - technicalities

Where are we now, on 7 May 2021?

- Draft amends Annex IV to Regulation 999/2001 – *feed ban provisions*
- Draft finalised with the Member States experts during the 1st trimester 2021
- Draft voted by the PAFF committee on 9 April 2021
- Regulatory Procedure with Scrutiny → 3-months scrutiny period by EP and Council (start 4 May)

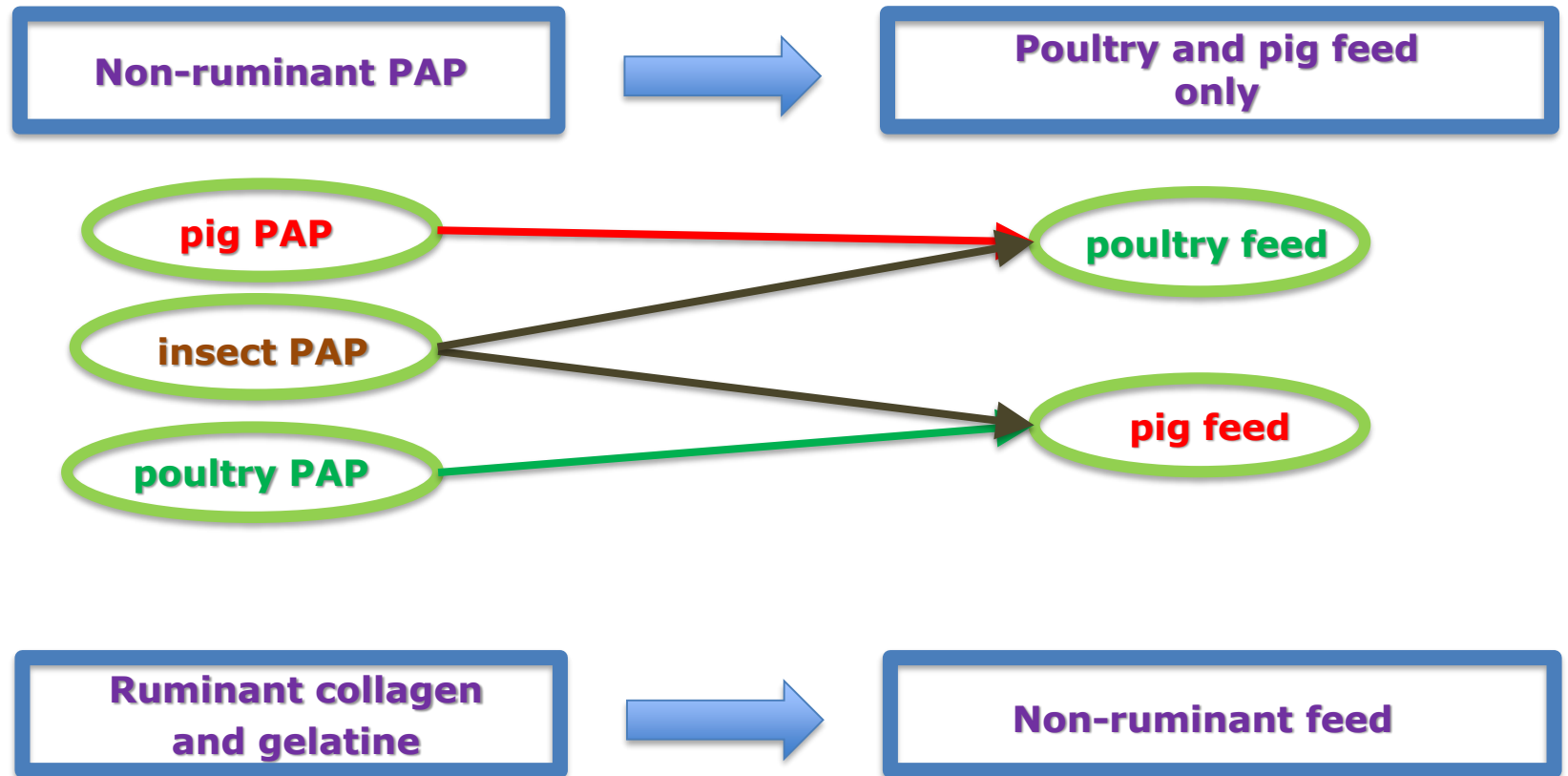

<ul style="list-style-type: none">Insect PAP in poultry and pig feed	October 2015
<ul style="list-style-type: none">Ruminant collagen and gelatine in the feed of non-ruminant farmed animals	September 2020

Strict conditions to prevent cross-contamination and intra-species recycling

- *Dedication of establishments remains the basic rule.*
- *Derogations are possible, provided that the production lines at least are dedicated*

Next steps

- End of the 3-months scrutiny period by the co-legislators on 4 August
- Adoption possibly in September
