
# Peste des Petits Ruminants – current situation in Bulgaria





### Measures undertaken

Based on Directive 92/119 and national contingency plan:

- Culling and burial of all susceptible animals in the affected villages.
- \* Establishment of protection (3 km) and surveillance (10 km) zones around the affected villages
- \* Sampling of small ruminants for serological and virological surveillance in all villages in the protection and surveillance zones. Target: detection of 5% with 95% confidence. Village is taken as epidemiological unit.
- \* Clinical examinations in all holdings with small ruminants in the municipalities bordering Turkey.
- Numerous of disinfections in the affected villages
- \* Ban of movement of susceptible animals within and from the zones.

## Further measures undertaken (1)

- 05/07/2018 CID (EU) 2018/954 of 4 July 2018 laying down certain protective measures in order to prevent the spread of Peste des Petits Ruminants in Bulgaria.
  - prohibited dispatch of small ruminants, as well as semen, ova and embryos of small ruminants from the affected areas to other parts of the country and other EU member states and third countries.
  - prohibited the placing on the market of certain commodities except some derogations as specified in this Decision.
  - CID (EU) 2018/1499 of 8 October 2018 amending CID (EU) 2018/954 measures extended to entire territory of the regions of Burgas, Yambol and Haskovo



Map 2- restriction zone, according to the CID 2018/954/EK


## Further measures undertaken (2)

- \* Active surveillance (clinical examination and serological and virological sampling) Target: detection of 5% with 95% confidence. Village considered to be an epidemiological unit.
  - in protection (3 km) and surveillance (10 km) zones around the affected villages.
  - enlarged surveillance zone covering the municipality along the border (established on 09/07/2018)
  - In 20 km zone around the affected villages (30/07/2018 3/08/2019)


- 102 positive/doubtful > 94 confirmed positive by EURL
- Extended surveillance in Aug-Sept 2018

## Further measures undertaken (4)

Enhanced surveillance in Yambol, Burgas and Haskovo regions:

- 249 villages (epi-units)
- Clinical examinations
- 30 samples per epi-unit (10% prevalence, 95% confidence)
- Sampling of small ruminants showing clinical signs for virological testing

#### Number of seropositive and doubtful samples in the villages concerned

- > 7 203 samples were tested, 6 seropositive, 3 doubtful
- No clinical signs suggesting PPR observed during the clinical examinations and sampling
- No evidence for virus circulation
- Measures are being enforced to remove the seropositives from the herds
