Reporting on:

- SARS-CoV-2 in minks and other animals of the family Mustelidae and in raccoon dogs
- CID 2021/788 adopted on 12 May 2021.
- One outbreak reported by Spain.



Spain

- 1 new SARS-CoV-2 outbreak in minks confirmed by RT-PCR (2021/4)
- In commercial farm with 65,263 minks: 11,784 breeding females and 53,479 young
- Confirmed on 8/6/2021
- Outbreak detected following a reported a positive PCR result in a farm worker (weekly tests on workers)
- Location:

Province: A Coruña

Municipality: Carral





Spain

- No clinical signs in minks. No increase in mortality.
- Epidemiological survey: ongoing possible human origin: one of the farm workers tested PCR positive on May 25th.

 One health communication (Public Health authorities, environmental authorities and animal health authorities)



Spain

Control measures

- Immobilization and census of the animals present on the farm.
- Immobilization in the farm of products and by-products of animal origin. □
 Carrying out an epidemiological survey.
- Review and reinforcement of the biosecurity measures of the facilities.
- Monitoring and clinical follow-up of the animals.
