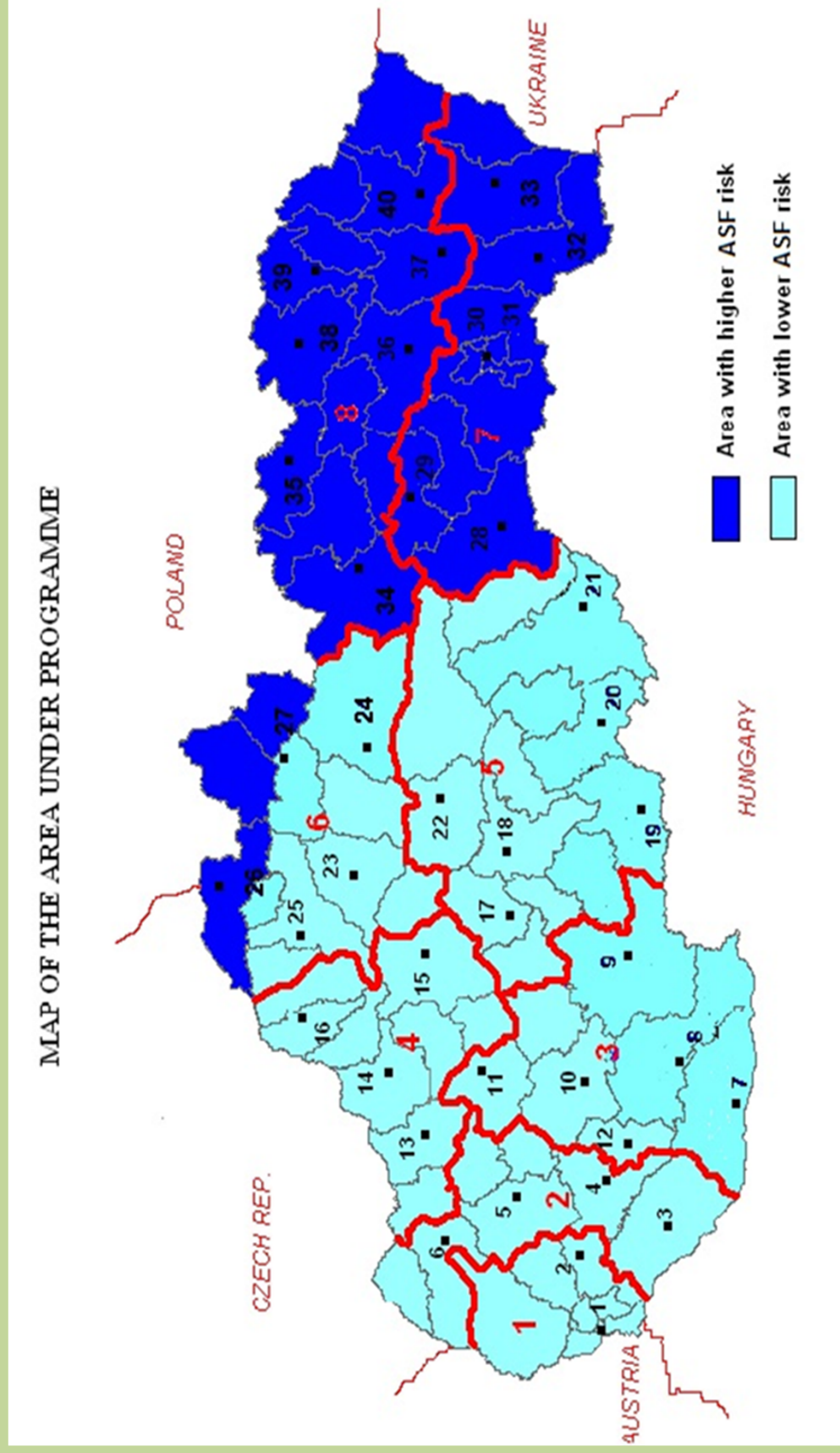
ASF in the Slovak Republic – **the aim of the programme**

- **To check/confirm free status of Slovakia as regards ASF**
(via surveillance/monitoring programme)
- **To adjust the preventive measures on the basis of the development of the situation in both mSs and Ill. countries**

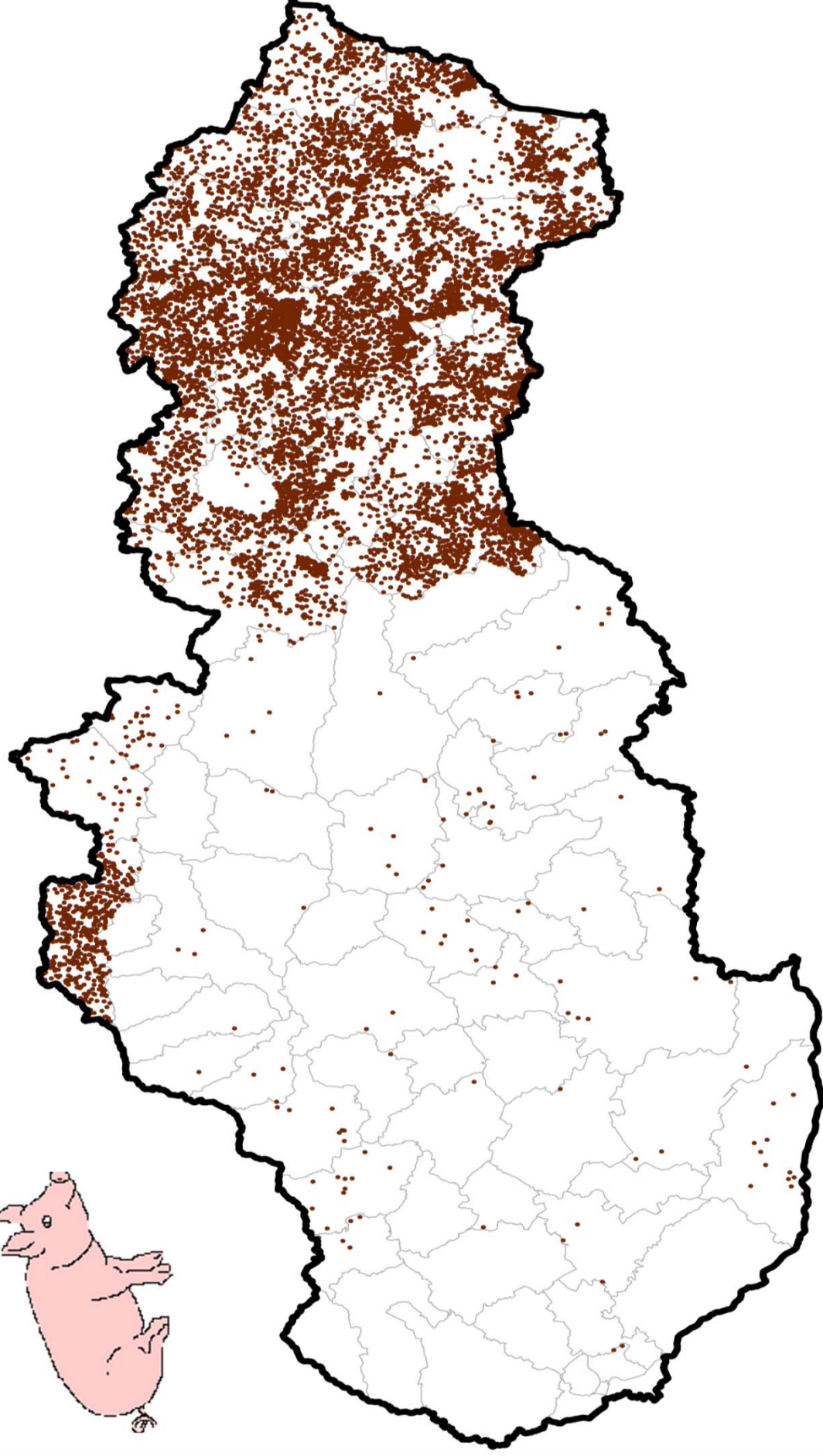
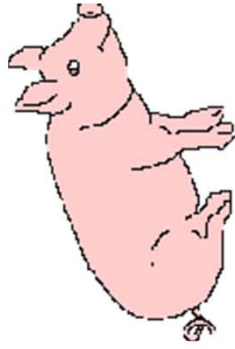


ASF division of the territory – ASF aspect

“ risk areas“ (defined by SK competent veterinary authority- SVFA SR) following occurrence of ASF in neighbouring countries , the differences between both areas was different level of surveillance and monitoring programme

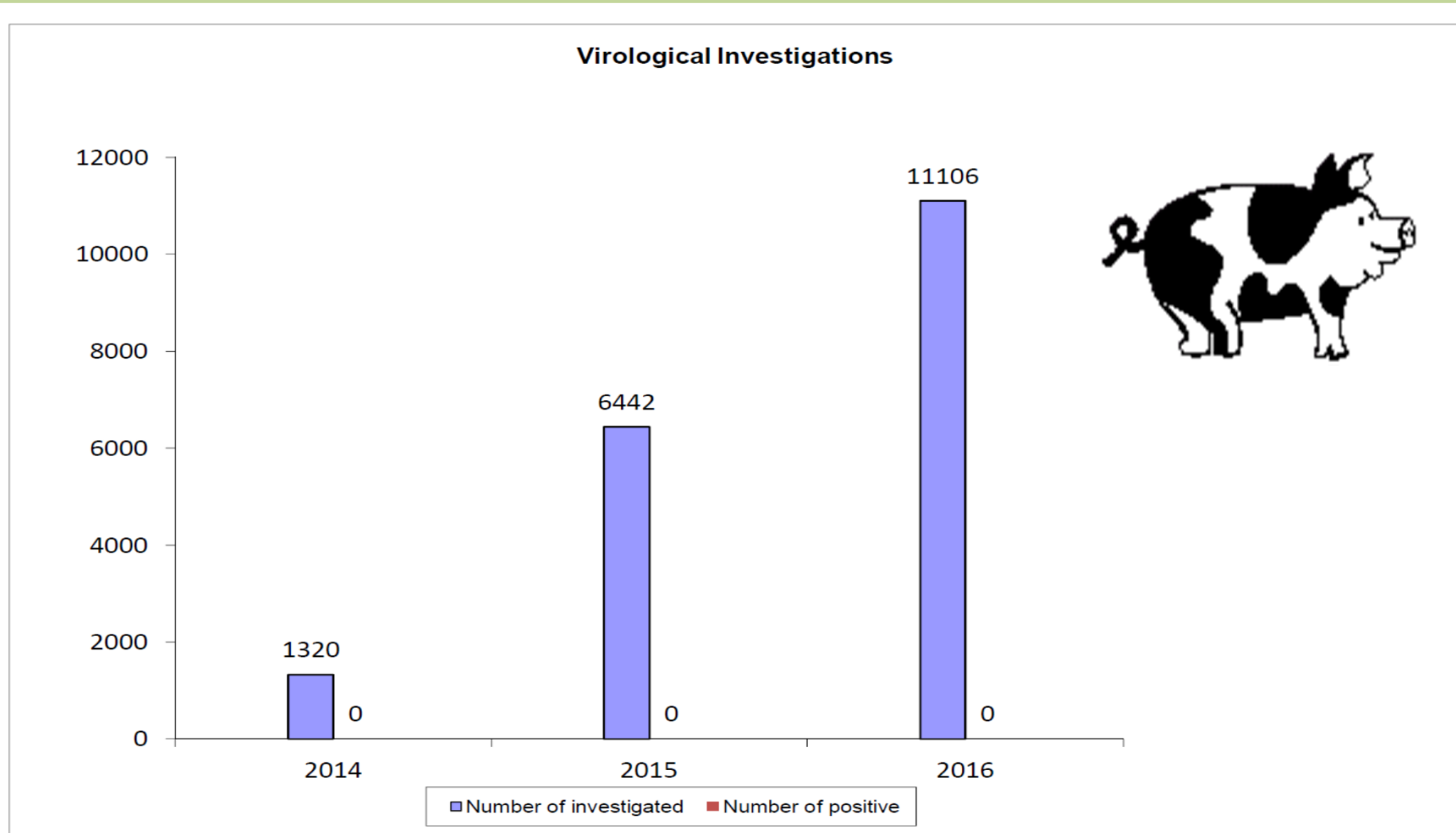

in wild boars in Slovakia in 2016

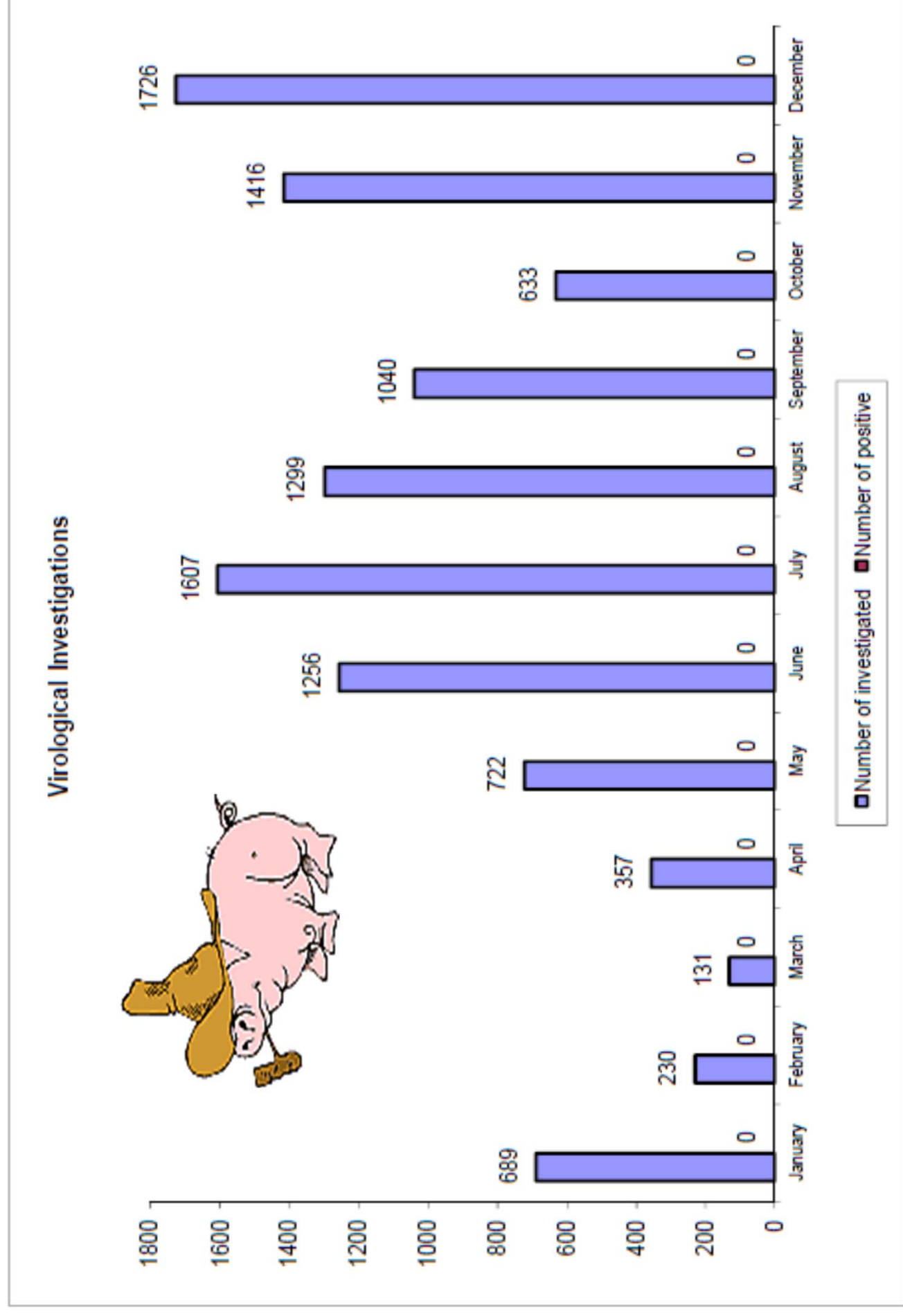


Laboratory Investigations: ASF in wild boars in Slovakia; period 2014 – 2016

Financial aspects of the programme - 2016

- **Laboratory diagnostics – domestic pigs and WBs***
- **Possible compensation for virologically positive hunted and found perished WBs (whole territory of the SR)**
- **Possible compensation for eradication ASF outbreaks in domestic pigs (whole territory of the SR)**
- **Slovak budget and co-financing procedure from the EU budget**

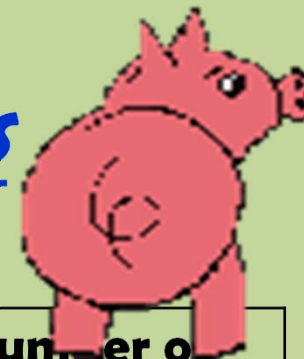
