 ASF


(via surveillance/monitoring programme)

 countries




# ASF division of the territorry – ASF aspect




# Laboratory Investigations of ASF in wild boars in Slovakia in 2016




#### <u>Laboratory Investigations: ASF in wild boars in</u> <u>Slovakia; period 2014 – 2016</u>
