



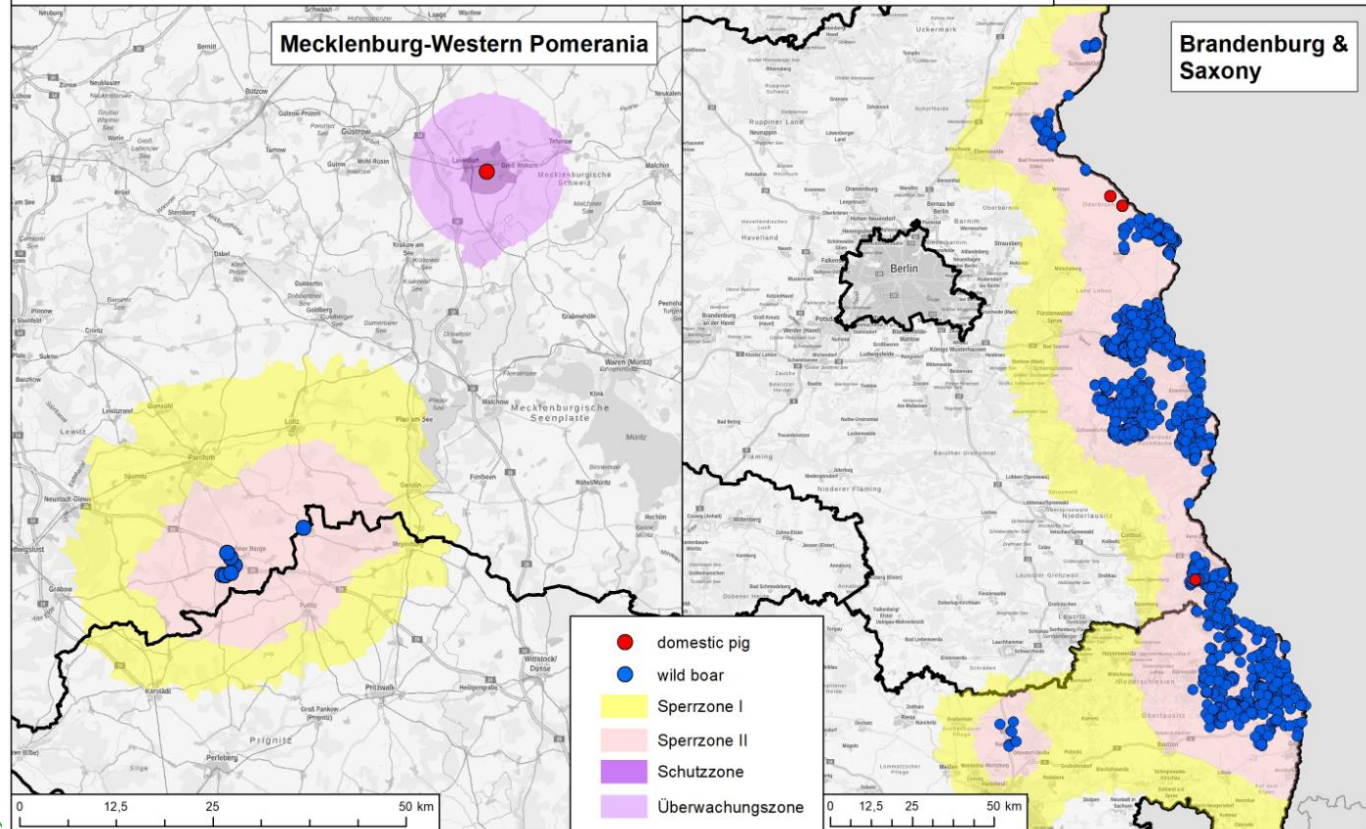

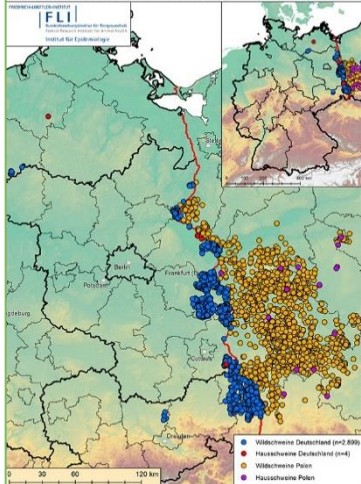

African Swine Fever positive pig farms and wild boar in Brandenburg, Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania and Saxony

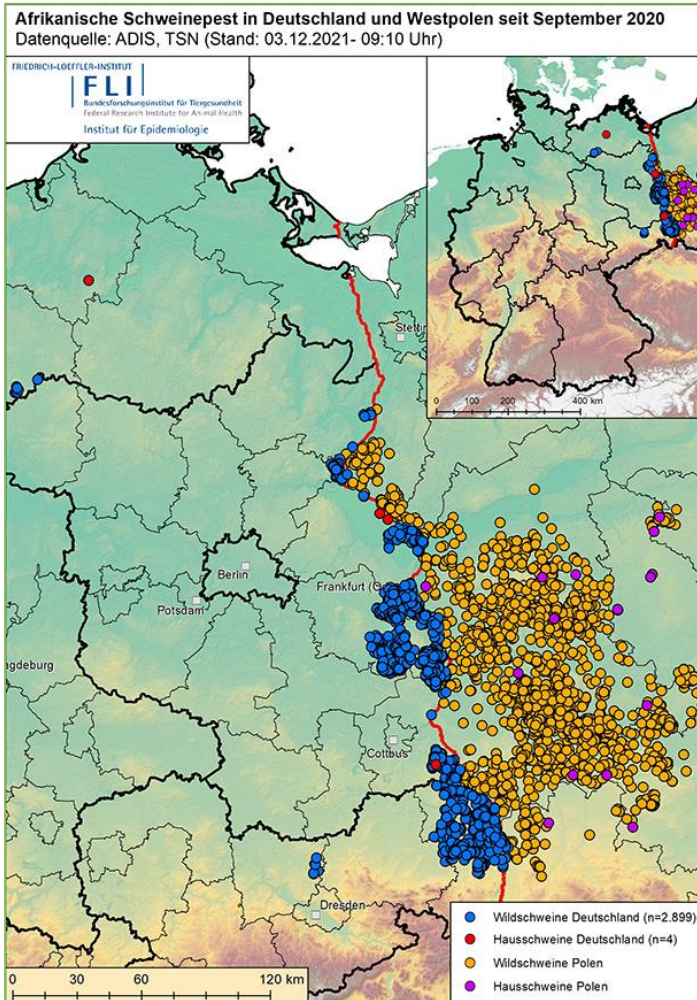

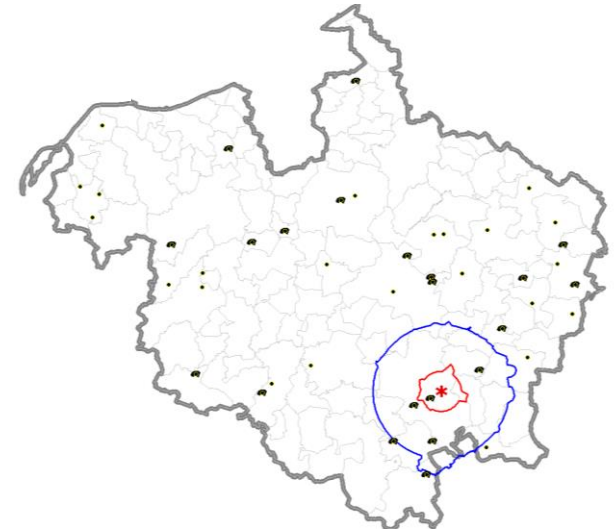
THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 March 2016 on transmissible animal diseases and amending and repealing certain acts in the area of animal health ('Animal Health Law')⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 259(1) thereof,

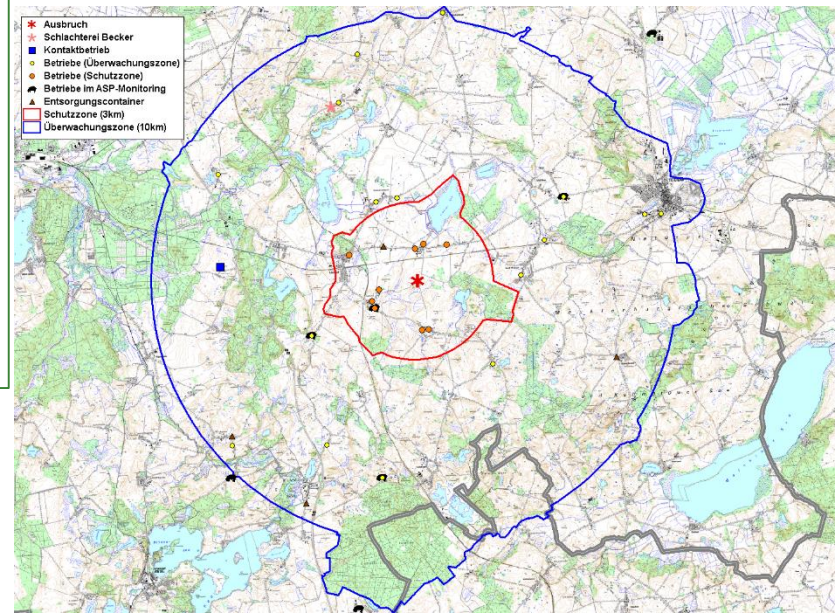
Whereas:

- (1) African swine fever is an infectious viral disease affecting kept and wild porcine animals and can have a severe impact on the concerned animal population and the profitability of farming causing disturbance to movements of consignments of those animals and products thereof within the Union and exports to third countries.

ASF – MV: measures

- Carcass/wild boar search (drones, dogs, traps)
- Hunting
- Samples taken of all shot and found dead wild boars
- Safe disposal of carcasses
- Biosecurity measures
- No movement of animals out of restricted zone



ASF – MV: measures

- Bonus paid for wild boar (100 Euro) in restricted zones
- Public awareness campaigns

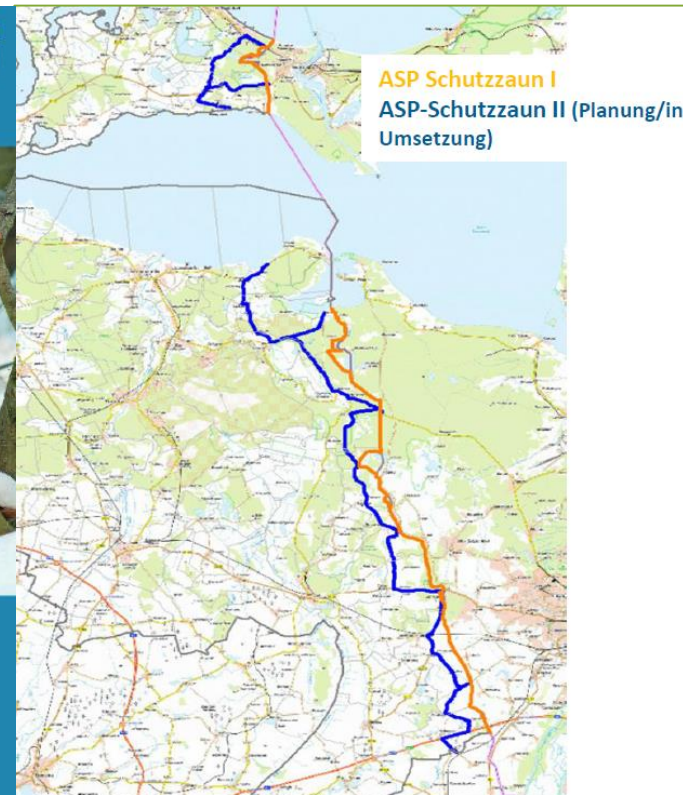


Abb. 1: LK VG mit Darstellung ASP-Schutz-

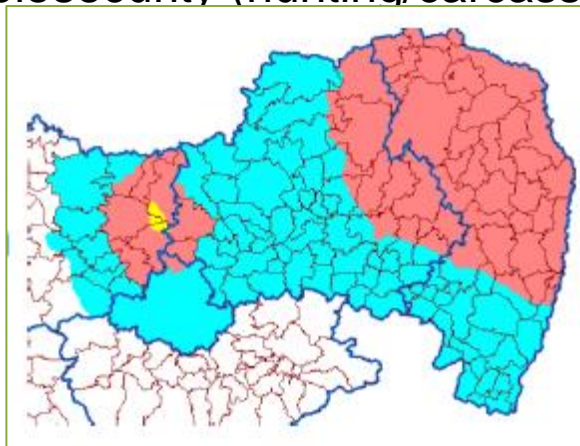

- enhanced biosecurity (hunting/carcass search)

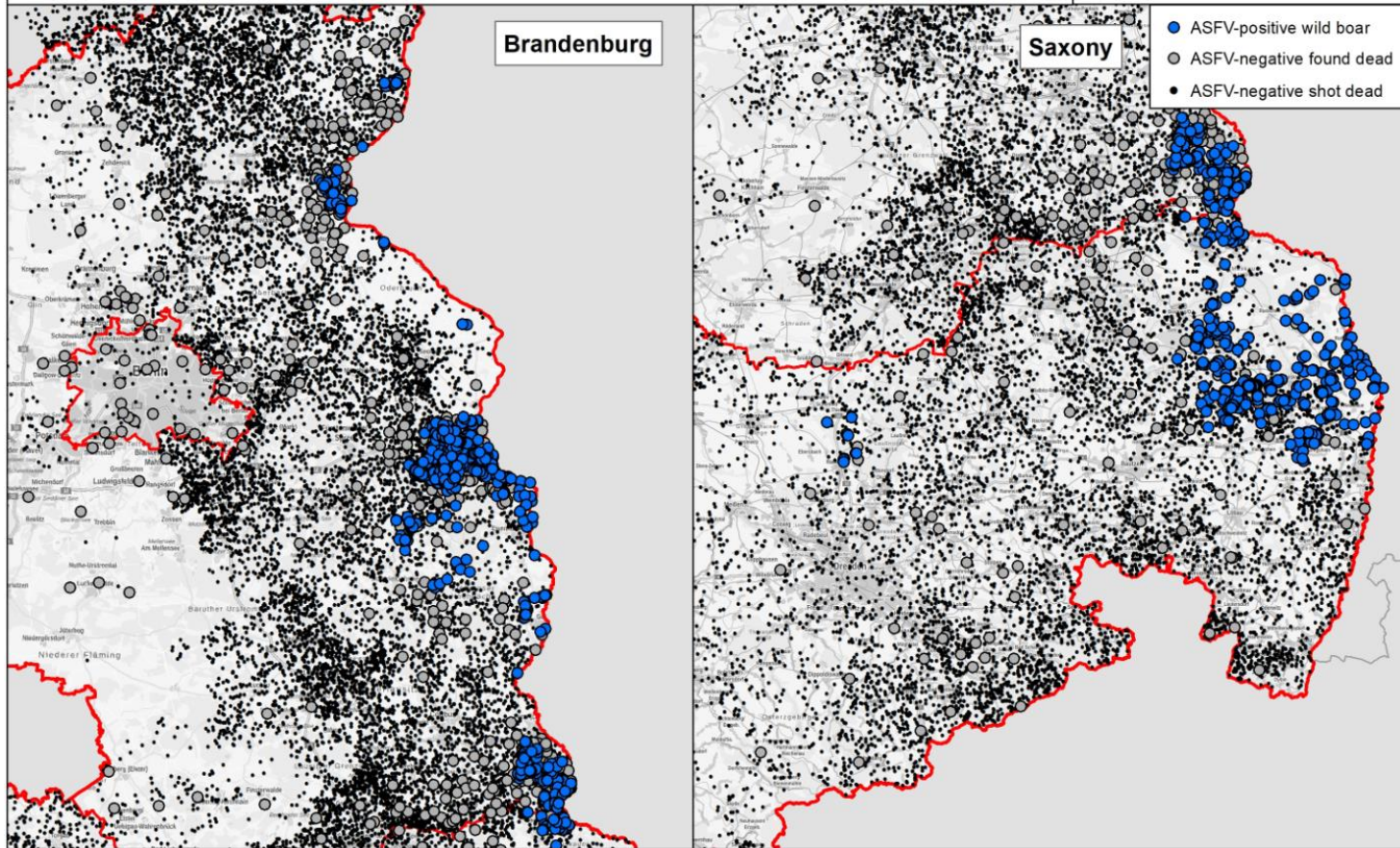


approx. 160 km electric fence
