AGENDA OF THE EU PREPARATORY MEETING ON 2 JUNE 2014 FOR THE WTO SANITARY AND PHYTOSANITARY COMMITTEE OF JULY 2014

The meeting will prepare the 60th regular meeting of the WTO Committee on Sanitary and Phytosanitary measures (SPS Committee) that will take place at the Centre William Rappard, Geneva on the **9-10th July 2014**. Informal meetings on private standards, the *ad hoc* procedure for resolution of issues and the Fourth Review of the WTO SPS Agreement are provisionally scheduled for the 8th July – possibly starting a day earlier on the 7th July in the afternoon.

At the preparatory meeting on the 2^{nd} of June, the European Commission (COM) intends to discuss with Member States (MS) the main points of the agenda of the next SPS Committee. At this stage, only the preliminary agenda is available. The final, official agenda will be circulated by the WTO Secretariat on the 27^{th} June 2014 via the official WTO airgram.
