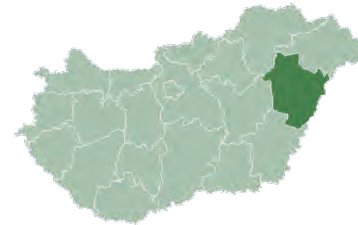
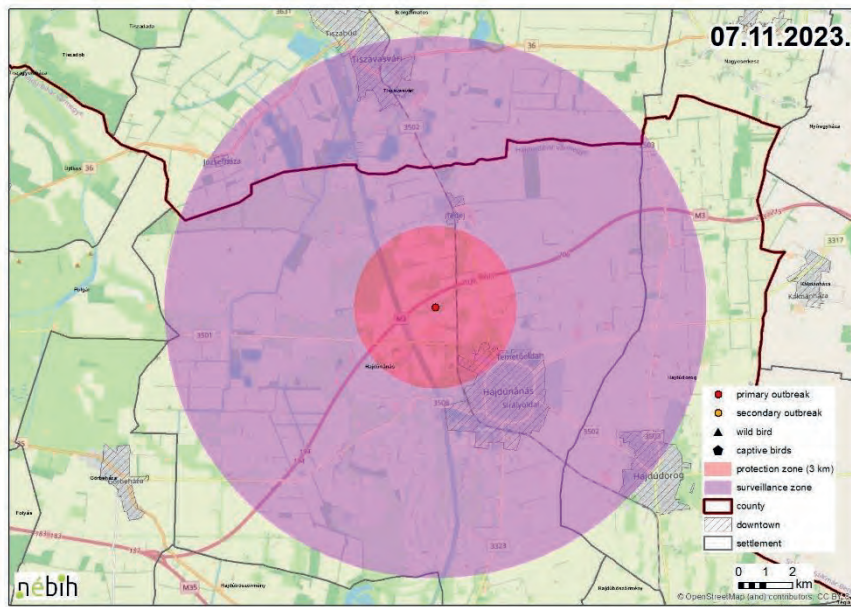

Hajdú-Bihar county: 7th November, breeding duck holding, 22 439 ducks



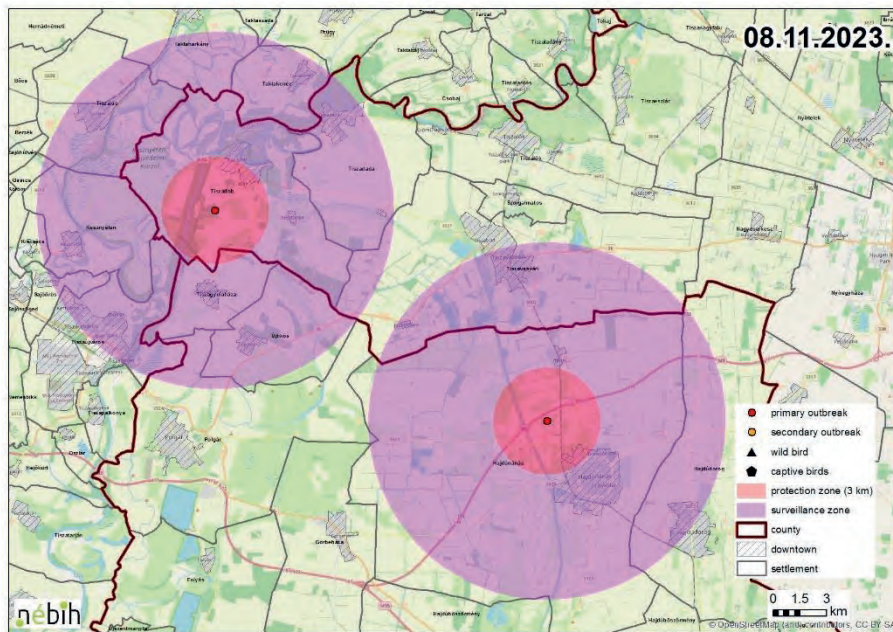

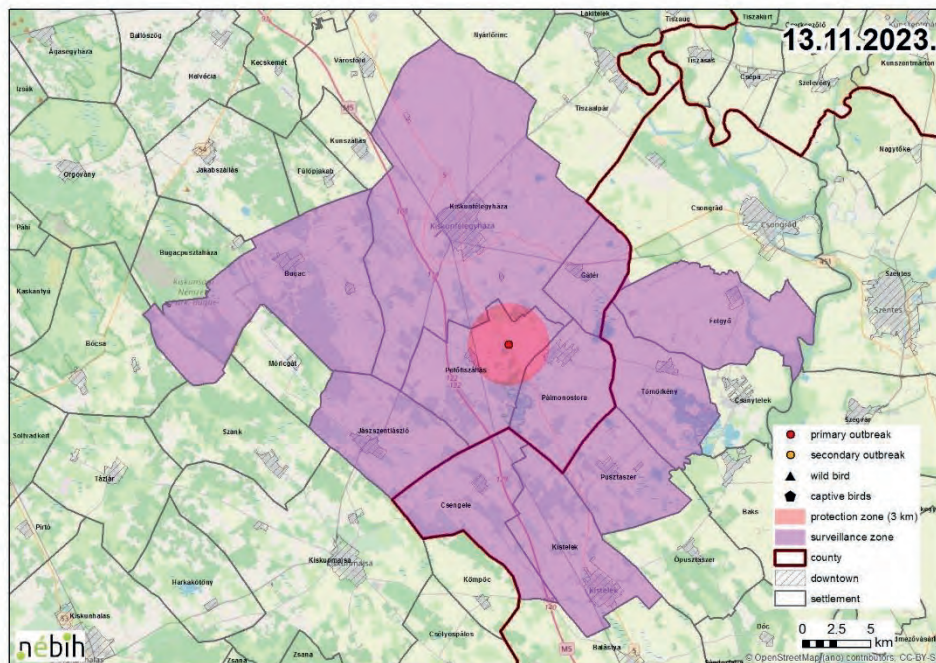
Szabolcs-Szatmár-Bereg county: 8th November, fattening duck holding, 51 257 ducks

Bács-Kiskun county: 12th November, breeding foie gras mulard duck holding, 7 100 mulard ducks



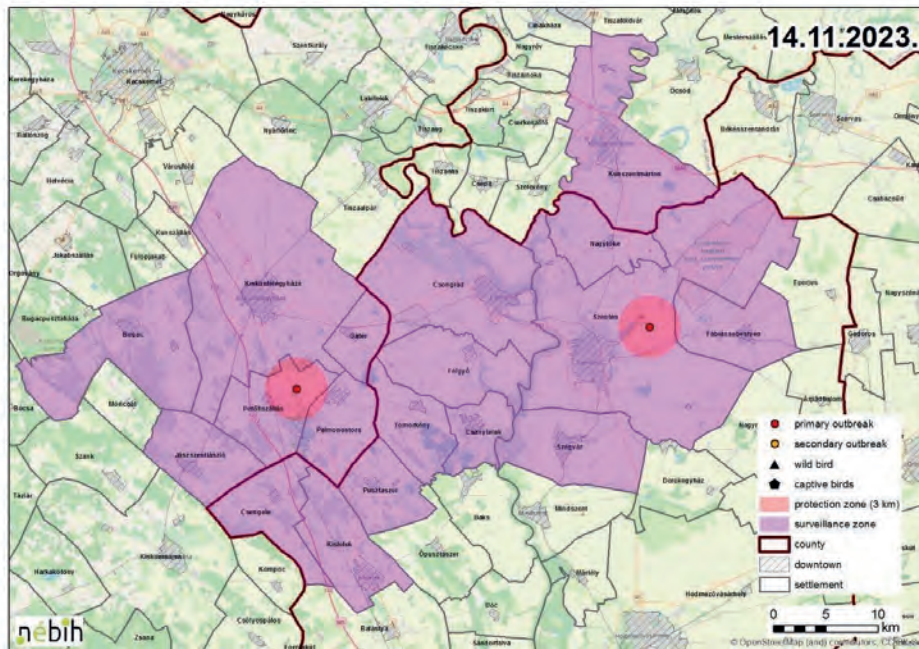

Csongrád-Csanád county: 14th November, fattening goose holding, 5 922 geese



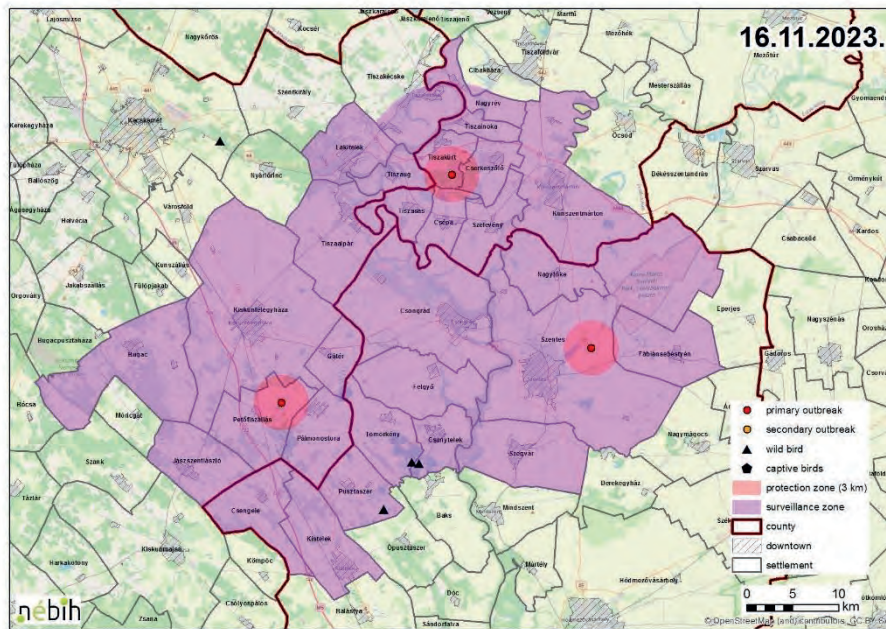

3 600 turkeys



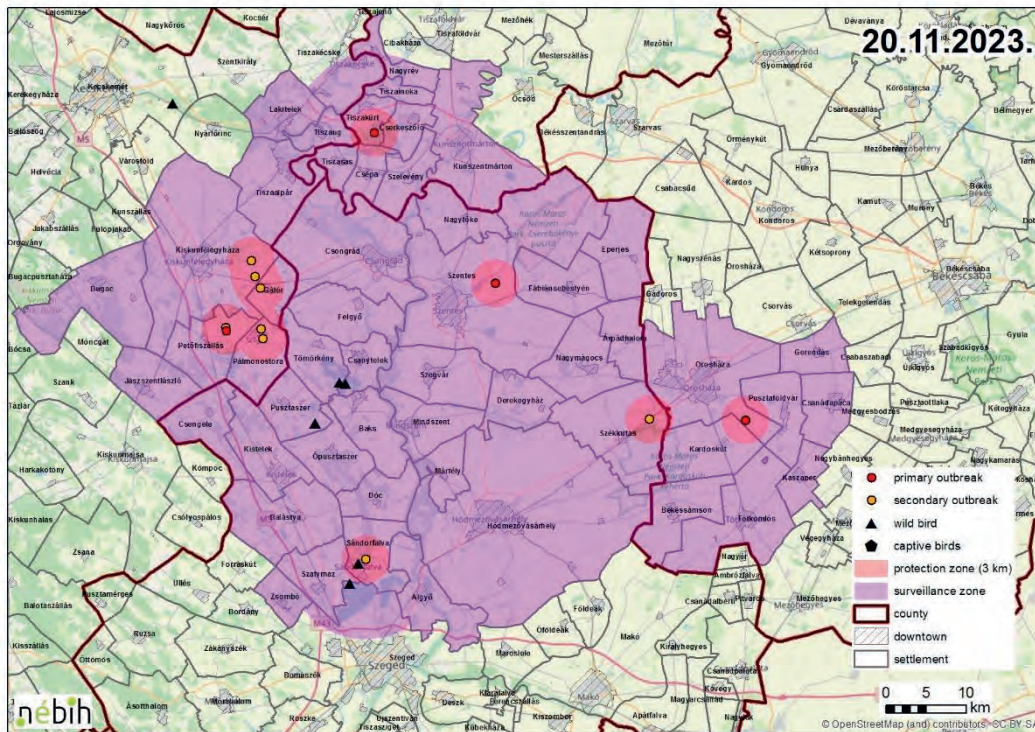

Békés county: 18th November, foie gras goose holding, 7 413 geese

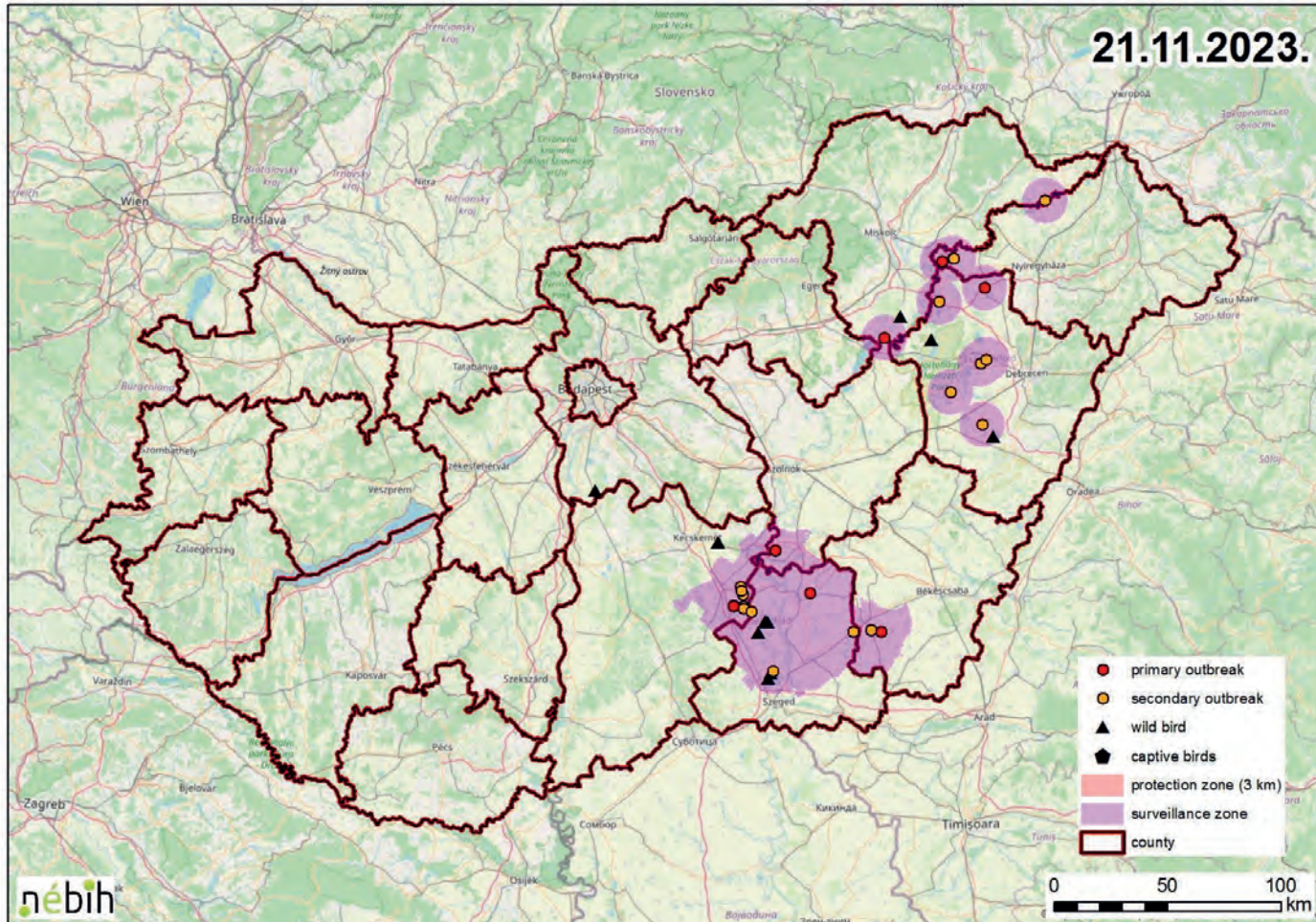

Current situation



HPAI in Hungary from the 7th until the 21st November 2023

Poultry

- **7 counties affected**
 - Hajdú-Bihar, Szabolcs-Szatmár-Bereg, Bács-Kiskun, Borsod-Abaúj-Zemplén, Csongrád-Csanád, Jász-Nagykun-Szolnok and Békés
- **Number of outbreaks: 25**
 - 7 primary and 18 secondary
 - ducks, geese, turkeys, hens

HPAI in Hungary from the 13th October until the 21st November 2023

Wild birds

13 wild bird outbreaks (26 wild birds)

- Eurasian teal (*Anas crecca*) (1): 13th October: Hajdú-Bihar county
- Crane (*Grus grus*): 3rd – 15th November: Hajdú-Bihar, Csongrád-Csanád, Pest, Borsod-Abaúj-Zemplén, Bács-Kiskun, Győr-Moson-Sopron

Measures

Highlights

- Transport – whole area of Bács-Kiskun, Csongrád-Csanád and Békés – before movement of waterfowls to slaughterhouse (swab – 72 h, have to wait the result)
- Transport – whole country – before technological movement of waterfowls (swab – 72 h, have to wait the result)
- Closed keeping – high risk counties
