B.01 Exchange of views and possible opinion of the Committee on a draft Commission Implementing Decision on the evolution of animal diseases in third countries.

B.02 Exchange of views and possible opinion of the Committee on a draft Commission Implementing Regulation amending Regulations (EC) No 136/2004 and (EC) No 282/2004 as regards the model of common veterinary entry document for products and animals and amending Regulation (EC) No 669/2009 as regards the model of common entry document for certain feed and food of non-animal origin. (HK)

The purpose of this draft is to allow the use of two different models of CVED for products and animals and CED for certain feed and food of non-animal origin, to lay down requirements for the completion of electronic CVEDs or CEDs and to set out the models of CVEDs and CED to be used in the new version of the TRACES system.

B.03 Exchange of views and possible opinion of the Committee on a draft Commission Implementing Decision amending Decision 2009/821/EC as regards the lists of border inspection posts and veterinary units in Traces. (BS)

Commission Decision 2009/821/EC lays down the list of border inspection posts (BIPs) approved in accordance with Directives 91/496/EEC and 97/78/EC and the list of central, regional and local units registered in the integrated computerised veterinary system (TRACES). This amendment proposes changes in the BIP approvals of Belgium, Denmark, Spain, Italy, Finland and Sweden, and in the TRACES units of Germany.

B.04 Exchange of views and possible technical agreement of the Committee on a draft Commission Implementing Regulation establishing the list of animals and products subject to official controls at border control posts, including their codes from the Common Nomenclature. (CJ)

As the new import requirements for composite products only will become applicable on 21 April 2021, the current list of such products in Commission Decision 2007/275/EC shall continue to apply until then. Hence, the list established in this draft Regulation does not cover composite products. The draft Regulation will be presented for a technical vote.

B.05 Exchange of views and possible technical agreement of the Committee on a draft Commission Implementing Regulation on the procedures for a coordinated performance of intensified controls at border control posts. (CJ)

This Draft Implementing Regulation lays down the procedures for a coordinated performance by the competent authorities of intensified controls on products of animal origin, germinal products and animal by-products at border control posts. The draft Regulation will be presented for a technical vote.

B.06 Exchange of views and possible technical agreement of the Committee on a draft Commission Implementing Regulation establishing the model official certificate and rules for issuing official certificates for goods which are delivered to vessels leaving the Union and intended for ship supply or consumption by the crew and passengers, or to NATO or a United States' military base. (IC)

The objective of the draft Implementing Regulation is to establish a model official certificate which is required by Commission Delegated Regulation based on Article 51 of Regulation (EU) 2017/625 (for consignments of goods in transit) to accompany consignments of goods from third countries to vessels leaving the Union and intended for ship supply or for supply of NATO/US military bases. The draft Regulation will be presented for a technical vote.
