Farm with two stables. One stable with 8.000 4 week old ducks  
Second stable 8.000 1 day old ducks

## 7 December

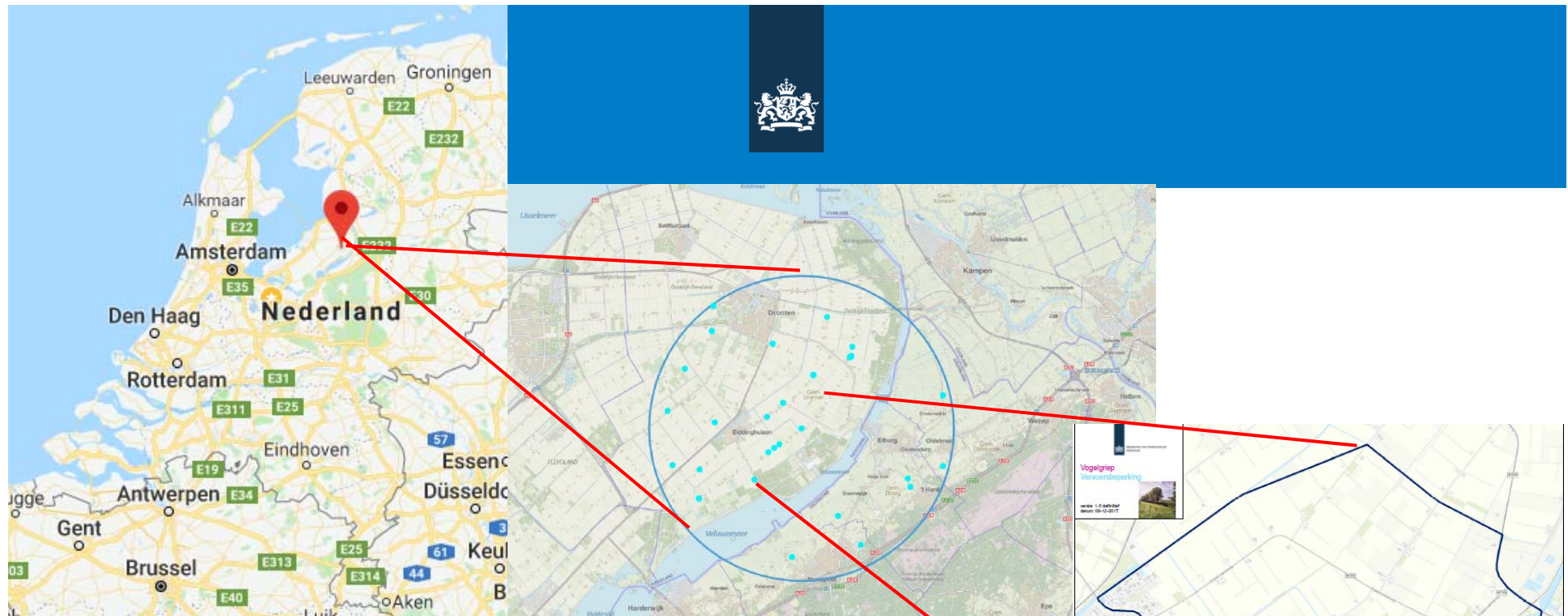
- AI Clinical signs in 4 week old ducks. Less food intake  
2% dead in 1 day

Visit by Expert team  
Samples to Ref lab

## 8 December 02:15

- Confirmation H5N6
- Culling of the animals with CO<sub>2</sub>
- Cleaning and Disinfection complete





### 3 km zone

- 2 fattening duck farms
- 1 broiler farm
- 1 laying hen farm

10 Km

3 Km

All screened on 8 and 9 December with negative result in PCR and serum.

**10 km zone** 27 poultry farms

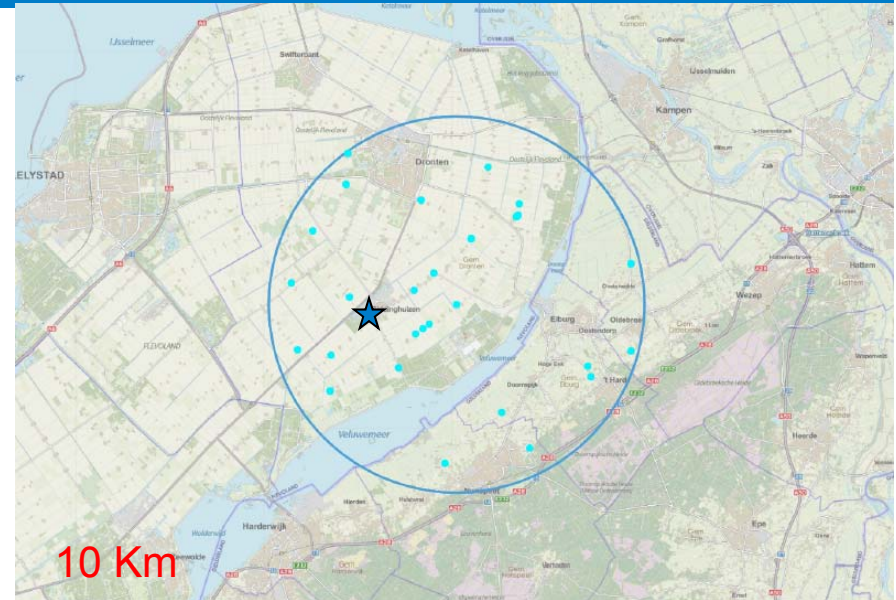


## 15 December 2017

- Notification of back yard farm Biddinghuizen

## 16 and 17 December 2017

- animals culled
  - 2 Swans
  - 5 Chickens
  - 7 Peacocks
  - 18 Ducks
  - 4 Guinea fowl
  - 4 Geese
- cleaning and disinfection of the holding





## HPAI in wild animals

- Notification of dead wild mute swans on the 7<sup>th</sup> of December
- 6 positive PCR H5N6





## National measures

- Obligation to keep commercial poultry inside
- Restricting visitors of poultry farms
- No bird shows
- 3/10 km areas: measures according 2005/94 – lifted per 9/1/2018
