


Update on Low pathogenic Avian Influenza of subtype H7N7 in poultry in Germany

36.100 laying hens kept outdoor (introduced on 21.10.2014)

08.06.: egg drop

09.06.: AIV H7 pos. (privat lab); Land lab

confirmed,

holding put under official

restriction

11.06.: AIV H7N7 (FLI),


all poultry culled and safely

disposed of

16.06.: cleansing and disinfection finished

LPAI H7N7, Landkreis Emsland: restricted areas, epidemiological investigations

- •<u>Restricted area (1.000 m around affected holding)</u>: 3 holdings (24.474 poultry): must be kept inside; no clinical signs and all negative PCR-results; final tests foreseen 08.07.2015
- •No introduction of poultry to the affected holding since 21.10.2014
- •No trade of poultry/poultry meat to and from the affected holding to other Laender, Member States or Third Countries; eggs delivered only to one establishment in Germany.
- •Contact holdings (linked by staff): no clinical signs and negative PCR-results.
- •Source of infection: unknown, but the poultry keeper had observed regular contacts of the laying hens in the open-air runs with wild birds.
