Analysis of major deficiencies detected during the non-discriminatory inspections and action plan to address them as provided for in Article 27(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1/2005

1. ANALYSIS OF THE MAJOR DEFICIENCIES DETECTED DURING THE NON-DISCRIMINATORY INSPECTIONS

For the purpose of this annual report, the following have been considered to be major deficiencies:

Generally, most frequent deficiencies have been detected during inspections of cattle and pigs: 8 deficiencies involving cattle (e. g. 2x means of transport, documentation, transport practices) and 5 deficiencies involving pigs (documentation, means of transport).

Unsuitable means of transport transport have been considered as major non – compliances which may have significant impact on the welfare of animals.

2. ACTION PLAN TO ADDRESS THE DEFICIENCIES DESCRIBED ABOVE:

All deficiencies are addressed in accordance with valid legislation and relevant methodical instructions (sanctions imposed depending on the circumstances, veterinary measures ordered by the inspector).
