

LPAI in Sweden 2018



Summary of outbreak

- Confirmed LPAI H5 23 May 2018.
- Breeding farm with game for restocking, commercial holding 1600 adult pheasants, 7000 chicken, 40 000 hatching eggs. There was also a hobby flock with 15 hens.
- The farm is situated in Burlöv, County of Skåne län in the south of Sweden.
- All necessary measures according to Directive 2005/94 are applied.
- Culling of animals concluded as of 30 May 2018.
- Preliminary disinfection concluded as of 31 May 2018.



Outbreak in one herd

- LPAI H5 was detected in the sampling of pheasants in the Swedish AI surveillance program.
- Further samples (swabs) were taken and LPAI H5 was confirmed 23 May 2018 after analysis with realtime-PCR and sequencing.
- No clinical symptoms in the holding.
- Source unknown but wild birds likely.
- A restricted zone of 1 km was established around the holding.
- No other commercial holdings in the restricted zone.



Information

- No movement of live poultry, hatching eggs or poultry products from restriction area.
- No hobby herds in restriction area.
- The analysis of the N-type is not yet finished.
- Written information to:
 - European Commission (who sent to MS)
 - CVO in the Nordic countries
 - Third countries

Summary HPAI in wild bird

In total 14 wild birds confirmed
with HPAI H5 until 7 June 2018
in Sweden.





- Since 9 January 2018:
209 wild birds tested
(update: 2018-06-07)
Green: negative
Red: positive
