Amoxicillin

The EU supports the proposed draft MRLs for amoxicillin in finfish because they do not raise any consumer safety concerns. These proposed draft MRLs are the same as the EU MRLs.

Ampicillin

The EU supports the proposed draft MRLs for ampicillin in finfish because they do not raise any consumer safety concerns. These proposed draft MRLs are the same as the EU MRLs.

Flumethrin

The EU supports the proposed draft MRL for flumethrin in honey because it does not raise any consumer safety concern. This proposed draft MRL is more conservative than the EU MRL.

Lufenuron

The EU supports the proposed draft MRLs for lufenuron in salmon and trout because they do not raise any consumer safety concerns. These proposed draft MRLs are the same as the EU MRLs.

Monepantel

The EU supports the proposed draft MRLs for monepantel in cattle tissues because they do not raise any consumer safety concerns. These proposed draft MRLs are the same as the EU MRLs.
