Reporting on:

- SARS-CoV-2 in minks and other animals of the family Mustelidae and in raccoon dogs
- CID 2021/788 adopted on 12 May 2021
- Covers all outbreaks reported since 16 February 2023
- New outbreak reported by Poland
- Unless unexpected changes, this will be last report based CID 2021/788



Poland

- 1 new SARS-CoV-2 outbreak in minks confirmed by RT-PCR on 20.03.2023:
- 2/2023 located in voivodeship Wielkopolskie, poviat Ostrzeszów
- Farm with 8.983 minks
- No clinical sings nor fatality in any outbreak (samples taken as a part of active surveillance)
- Origin of the virus: investigation ongoing
- Control measures include:
 - · Isolation and observation,
 - ban on movement of animals,
 - official supervision for treatment of animal by-products, feed, bedding,
 - cleaning and disinfection
 - regionalisation and surveillance
