# FMD in DEU Brandenburg (BB) - 1st case since 1988



## FMD measures in Brandenburg

 → Suspicion case on January 16<sup>th</sup>: one goat of four with leasons, all killed and tested negative – 12 km north of primary case, district of Barnim








## FMD measures in Brandenburg and Berlin

→ All tested establishments in RZ negative, including killed animals of the contact establishment (hey delivery)

→ In Berlin, districts of Lichtenberg, Treptow-Köpenick and Pankow are also within the surveillance zone







### FMD additional measures

- → Sampling of wild cloven-hooved animals ongoing
- → so far negative (additionally using of old ASF-taken samples)
- → FMD testing in 2024 of 72 BTV negative animals with clinical signs
- → Stand still in all of BB and BE for cloven-hoofed animals prolonged till January 18<sup>th</sup>
- → single hunt in BB allowed, no hunting in RZ in Berlin
- → EU VET taking place since January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025



#### FMD first conclusions

- → So far no more infected establishments
- → MS received lists of animals from BB since December 1st, 2024 so far no information of conspicious animals
- → Role of wildlife in investigation
- → Source of infection so far inconclusive role of dog promenader alongside/through water buffaloes?
- → All sorts of communication in ultrasonic speed uncontrollable
- → Many additional challenges regards vaccination strategies
- → EU VET taking place since January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025
