Background 1

- ❖ Regulation 882/2004 -new obligations
 - Article 4(6) internal audits- National Audit Systems (NAS)
 - Article 41 Multi Annual National Control Plan (MANCP)
 - Article 44 Annual Report (AR) on implementation of MANCP





Background 2

- ❖ Article 43 of Regulation 882/2004 provision for Commission guidelines
- 2 working groups established
 - "MANCP" group guidelines for MANCP and Annual Reports
 - "NAS" group guidelines for audits under Article
 4(6)
 - Evolved into "networks" to share experiences, good practices and keep guidelines under review





Network Activities

- Information sharing
 - presentations by participants and workshops to discuss ways and means
 - factual and non judgemental
 - over time more critical evaluation and identification of good practice
- Other contributions
 - NAS group identified training needs that contributed to the BTSF audit training
 - MANCP group developed the executive summary for Annual Reports





Disseminate good practice

- Reference documents by network –guidance on practical aspects
 - > Non-binding, and not a formal audit standard
 - Accepted as a legitimate approach to implement legal requirements
 - Can be wholly or partially incorporated into existing arrangements

Working methods

- Workshops and discussion at plenary meetings
- Sub-groups to develop principles agreed by plenary group into working texts
