





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Each year, billions of live animals are transported

- Increased citizens concern
- High interest of European Parliament
- To contribute to the debate on the upcoming revision of EU animal welfare legislation







## Main factors behind live animal transport

- Regulatory factors
- Economic factors

Trends in animal transport

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### There are no EU comprehensive centralised data on animal transport

- EU data on the transport of live animals are fragmented
- Member states are not required to collect and report data on live animal transport
- Current national and EU databases are not appropriate for the extraction and analysis of data on animal transport






### Economic factors encouraging the transport of live animals

- Specialisation of livestock sector
- Concentration in the slaughter sector
- Differences in animal production and slaughter costs between member states
- Marginality of transportation costs
- Consumer preferences

#### Number of slaughterhouses in Poland (2010-2022)






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## Animal suffering is not reflected in transportation costs or meat prices

- Few data are available on the financial consequences
- Transport of unfit animals may bring financial gain for producers
- Low sanctions compared to the price of animal








## EU animal transport legislation is not evenly enforced across member states

- EU animal transport legislation provides the baseline that member states must respect to ensure animal welfare during transport
- Penalty setting and application is delegated to member states
- There are significant differences in enforcement between member states







## The CAP is focused on elements other than animal welfare during transport

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## There is no common meat labelling standard

### EUlevel

- No comprehensive labelling scheme
- The only EUwide compulsory labelling scheme for animal welfare applies to eggs

## National level

- Variousnational labellingschemes
- Voluntarycertification for animalwelfare-related products



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## Challenges and opportunities for EU policy makers and stakeholders:

- Identifying alternatives to live animal transport.
- Providing better information to consumers to help them make informed choices.
- Assigning monetary value to animal suffering and taking account of this in the cost of transport and in the price of meat.
- Obtaining a comprehensive centralised overview of animal transport, monitoring the conditions of live animals during transport, and promoting logistical optimisation.
- Promoting structural changes to move towards a more sustainable food supply chain.
