Article 18 of the OCR

- 1. Official controls (OC) of products of animal origin by CA
- 2. OC related to meat production
 - a) By official veterinarian (OV)
 - b) Under the supervision of the OV
 - c) Under the responsibility of the OV
- 3. Assistance by slaughterhouse staff
- 4. Health marking
- 5. End responsibility with OV
- 6. Classification of production and relaying areas for live bivalve molluscs
- 7. Legal bases for delegated Regulation
- 8. Legal basis for implementing Regulation
- 9. Pilot projects



Article 18 of the OCR: Some differences from current rules

- **1. Clear definition** of "under the supervision of the OV" and "under the responsibility of the OV" (Art 17)
- 2. Conditions, including species, for assistance by slaughterhouse staff fixed in stone
- 3. No possibility anymore for adaptations under national law



Overall suggestions during consultations

- > Risk based
- > Flexibility, focus on food safety
- > Epidemiological situation considered
- >Adaptations for low-capacity slaughterhouses
- >Approved veterinarian
- >Use of technological tools
- >Consequent use of terminology



Commission Delegated Regulation in accordance with Article 18(7)

- Derogations to basic requirements on ante-, postmortem inspection (AMI/PMI) and auditing
 - FIGUES OF MIWHO emergency
 - PERFORMS/PILIPEINTEASKS red grouse
- Derogations for production and relaying ares for bivalve molluscs
- Minimum requirements for official veterinarians, official auxiliaries and other staff from competent authorities and slaughterhouses (e.g. training)

Commission Delegated Regulation in accordance with Article 18(7): AMI in slaughterhouses

| | By OV | Supervision | Responsibility |
|-----------------------|-------|----------------|---|
| Poultry and lagomorph | | | Remaining tasks in slaughterhouse in case of AMI at holding of provenance by OV |
| Other species | | Specific tasks | |

Under consideration/discussion:

- Possible at the holding of provenance by OV in all species – High focus on quality and verification of food chain information by OV
- Only OV (broad definition) in case of emergency slaughter

Commission Delegated Regulation in accordance with Article 18(7): Postmortem inspection (PMI)

| | By OV | Supervision | Responsibility |

| Poultry and lagomorph | | | Low-capacity slaughterhouse – discontinuous |
| Other species | | | slaughter |

Under consideration/discussion:

- Definition of low capacity slaughterhouse discontinuous slaughter
- Presence of official auxiliary (OA) in low capacity slaughterhouses



Commission Delegated Regulation in accordance with Article 18(7): Derogations for reindeer and grouse

Based on (agreed) adaptations by FI, SE and NO Under consideration/discussion:

Derogation in case of direct supply of reindeer meat

More flexibility for assistance by slaughterhouse

staff

Derogation for grouse

Limited to Northern regions with geographic constrains during certain period of the year



Commission Delegated Regulation in accordance with Article 18(7): Requirements (training) for OV, OA, ...

Under consideration/discussion:

- ➤ Third category of CA: Trainingrequirements for "other staff of competent authorities"
- > Less theoretical training
- >Linking to tasks
- >Involvement veterinary students



Commission Implementing Regulation in accordance with Article 18(8)

> Specific requirements for performance of official

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- Practical arrangements AMI/PMI
- CQISTOT IROUNS ia AND LITTED IN THE CONTROL OF THE
- DEDICATE MEDITAMENTS health marking
- Conditions for classification production and relaying areas live bivalve molluscs
- Specific requirements for performance of official controls on milk, milk products and fishery products

Commission Implementing Regulation in accordance with Article 18(8): practical arrangements under consideration/discussion

- ➤ More risk-based approach in line with the 2011-2013 EFSA Opinions on the revision of meat inspection
- > Visual inspections <-> incisions and palpations
 - ✓ Balance between public health and animal health
 - ✓ Trade considerations
 - ✓ Differentiation young ruminants older ruminants
 - ✓ Additional inspections and palpations if abnormalities have been found



Commission Implementing Regulation in accordance with Article 18(8): non-compliance issues under consideration/discussion

- More attention to non-compliance with good hygiene practices including visual contamination of carcases
- > Quid abnormal sexual odour?
 - 1. Unfit for human consumption, or
 - 2. Limitation on use meat, or
 - 3. Considered outside scope of official controls (quality issue for FBO)



Commission Implementing Regulation in accordance with Article 18(8):microbiological hazards under consideratoin/discussion

➤ Salmonella control on carcases of all species (similar to control on pig carcases)

> Campylobacter control on carcases of broilers



Commission Implementing Regulation in accordance with Article 18(8):other products of animal origin under consideration/discussion

- > Specific working group meeting with CA on possible revision of controls of live bivalve molluscs
- > Fishery products: no major changes envisaged
- ➤ Milk and milk products: maintain OV for controls at primary production?
