





Progress in ongoing discussions - 1

- Act published on 25 March:
 - Addition of composite products, hay and straw to goods to be checked at BCP
- Acts adopted and transmitted to Council and EP:
 - Training of BCP staff
 - Derogations from BCP requirements
- Acts voted in PAFF:
 - Prior notification
 - Minimum requirements for BCPs





Progress in ongoing discussions - 2

- Discussion with other COM services close to finalisation:
 - Return of consignments after refusal of entry by third country
 - Wood packaging material
 - Intensified controls
 - Monitoring of consignments to the place of destination
 - Exemptions from BCP controls
 - Transit, transhipment, onward transportation
 - IMSOC





Progress in ongoing discussions - 3

- Discussions with MS experts close to finalisation for:
 - Details on physical/identity/documentary checks
 - Identity and physical checks at control points
- Discussions ongoing:
 - Frequencies of identity and physical checks at BCPs
- Discussions to be launched (relevant as of 2021):
 - Specific composite products/exempted fr. BCPs
 - Single set of certificates with AH/food safety guarantees
