

1. ANALYSIS OF THE MAJOR DEFICIENCIES DETECTED DURING THE NON-DISCRIMINATORY INSPECTIONS:

In 2016, official inspectors of the State Food and Veterinary Service (SFVS) carried out 8306 checks to evaluate the conformity of animal transportation with requirements of Council Regulation (EC) 1/2005. The analysis of major infringements is given in the table below:

Penalties for breach of requirements were imposed in 15 cases. 12 cases were reported as laid down in Article 26 of Regulation 1/2005. In other cases dates for correction of nonconformities were fixed.

2. ACTION PLAN TO ADDRESS THE DEFICIENCIES DESCRIBED UNDER POINT

Training for SFVS official veterinary inspectors who perform official control of animals during transport (general conditions of transport of animals, trade, checks of transport documents and journey logs) were organized on 29 June 2016.

Cooperation with Competent Authorities in other Member States and notification of infringements as laid down in Article 26 of Regulation 1/2005 was carried out.
