




ASF in Germany: Intensive Search in Saxony

Overview found dead & traffic accidents






First search cycle: 11.11.-19.11.2020 area at risk 53 finds/ 7 positive






Second search cycle: 24.11.-08.12.2020 area at risk and buffer zone 10 finds/ 7 positive
