

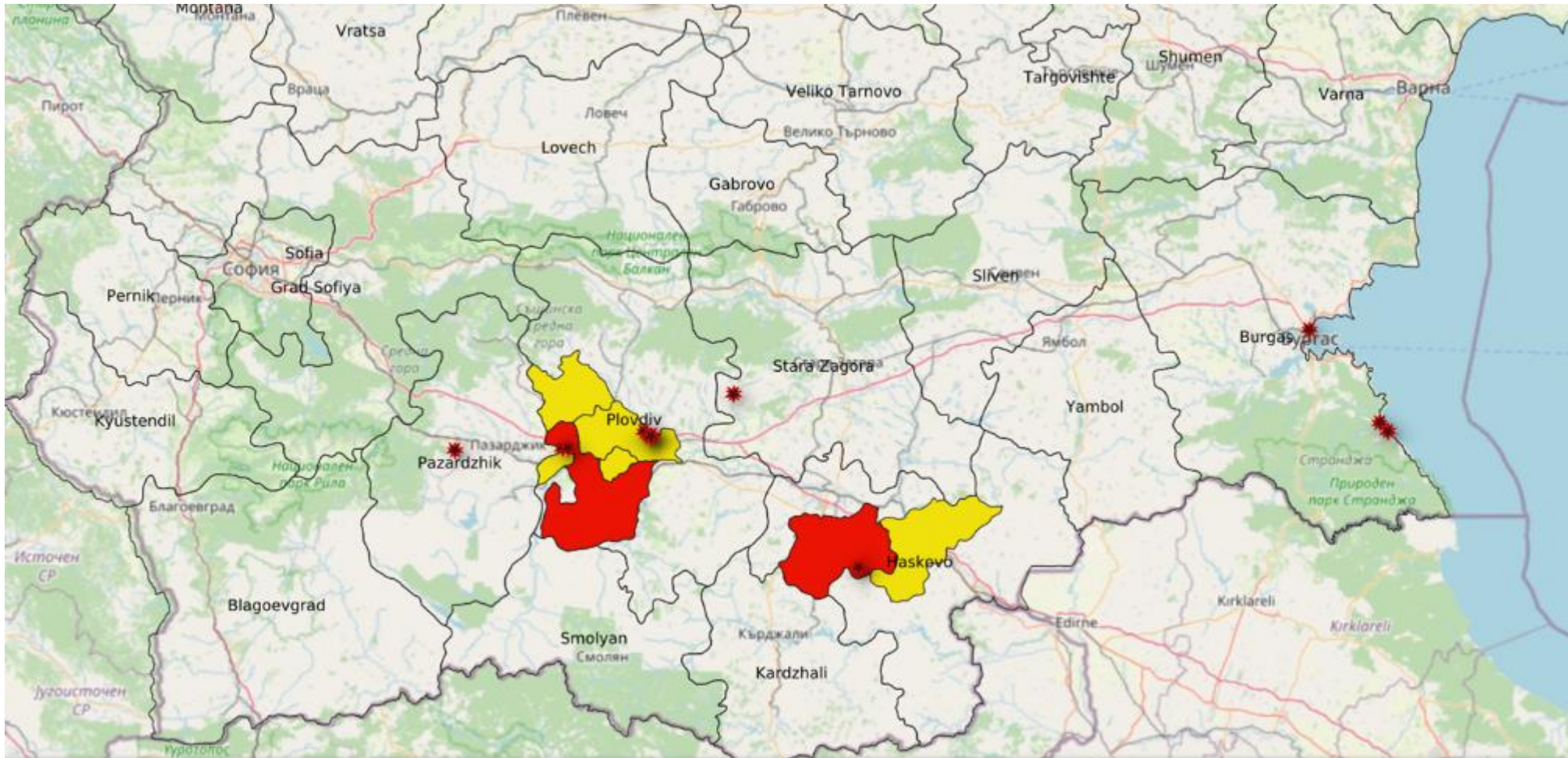

- enhanced biosecurity measures in farms
- enhanced surveillance in wild birds
- a further restriction zones to be established (under consideration)
