MTBC in cattle –

Dairy production in Thuringia

After suspicion during slaughter, sampling and testing was performed

Notification on October 13rd, 2022

- → 3245 bovines
- → 1300 milking cows
- → 3 different epidemiological units, some km apart





MTBC in cattle – measures as of DelReg2020/689 Art. 20 and 24

- → Withdrawal of disease-free status
- → Movement restrictions
- → Safe disposal of positive animals and milk
- → Tuberculin skin tests ongoing so far 3 positive, 3 not negative, all euthanised
- → Epidemiological enquiry



MTBC in cattle – epidemiological results

- → Movements within the last 5 years
- → 1/2 was slaughtered
- → Member States
- → Third Countries
- → national
