About this initiative

Summary

Based on new scientific evidence, EU rules on animal welfare during transport will be replaced with a new regulation to improve the welfare of animals and ensure fair competition for businesses.

New measures will target in particular:

- · fitness for transport
- · watering & feeding intervals
- · journey times & resting periods
- · space allowance
- · means of transport
- transport conditions
- exports to non-EU countries.

The regulation will simplify current rules and contribute to a sustainable food system.





Top 10 EU citizens' residence




