1. ANALYSIS OF THE MAJOR DEFICIENCIES DETECTED DURING THE NON-DISCRIMINATORY INSPECTIONS

For the purpose of this annual report, the following have been considered to be major deficiencies:

- 1.1. Non-realistic journey plans for long distance journeys;
- 1.2. Not sufficient condition of some animals (not fit for transport);
- 1.3. Lack of litter in vehicle for long distance journey;
- 1.4. Some technical problems on vehicles (not working fans or control lightning).

2. ACTION PLAN TO ADDRESS THE DEFICIENCIES DESCRIBED UNDER POINT 1.

- 2.1. On meetings with local level officials is pointed out, that allways they must control journey plans before loading of animals with relevant websites (Google maps, Via Michelin).
- 2.2. Some information about how to assess animals fitness for transport is multiplied and sended to local officials. They are recommended to assess animals condition before loading. Also control is the amount of litter is proportional with lenght of journey.
- 2.3. To some transporters was applied prescriptions about technical condition of vehicle.
