5 independent outbreaks of Aujeszky disease



Four wild boar farms (animals for hunting)

Department of Nièvre (58)

- Establishment holding about 250 wild boars
- Outbreak confirmed by NLR the 26 november 2021

Department of Allier (03)

- Establishment holding 31 wild boars
- Outbreak confirmed by NLR the 7 december 2021

Department of Corrèze (19)

- Establishment holding 110 wild boars
- Outbreak confirmed by NLR the 29 September 2021

Department of Gers (32)

- Establishment holding about 40 wild boars
- Outbreak confirmed by NLR the 16 december 2021

One pig backyard

Department of Alpes-de-Haute-Provence (04)

- Establishment holding **2 feeder pigs** (backyard)
- Outbreak confirmed by NLR the 27 december 2021



5 independent outbreaks of Aujeszky disease

For all outbreaks:

- Serological suspicions of Aujeszky's disease through annual surveillance
- No clinical sign
- Epidemiological surveys
 - ⇒ favorable investigations
- Biosecurity in the outbreaks on farms
 - => appropriate level
- ⇒ Main hypothesis :
 - + infection via wildlife (all outbreaks)
 - + resurgence of a previous outbreak (Segonzac)





Measures taken in the outbreaks on farms

- Ban on swine movements
- Stamping out
 - in the outbreak of Allier: finalised since december 17
 - in the outbreak of Corrèze: finalised since january 8;
 - in the outbreak of Nièvre: in progress;
 - In the outbreak of Gers: in progress
 - In the outbreak of Alpes-de-Haute-Provence: in progress
- After the end of the stamping out, before the repopulation : Cleaning / Disinfection
 - in the outbreak of Allier: finalised since december 20
 - In other outbreaks: in progress



Measures taken at administrative level (Department)

- Disease-free status in Corrèze, Nièvre, Gers, Allier and Alpes-de-Haute-Provence departments has been immediately suspended in accordance with article 82 of the Commission delegated regulation 2020/689
- Restrictions of movements of pigs from the departments towards disease-free areas has been taken in accordance with the Commission delegated regulation 2020/688

=> suspension of the free-status can be lifted if all pigs in the affected holding were slaughtered and results of an epidemiological enquiry are favorable

Restoration of the disease-free status and end of restrictions of movements:

- Corrèze: 8 january
- Nièvre: awaiting end of the stamping out
- Gers: awaiting end of the stamping out
- Allier: 17 December
- Alpes-de-Haute-Provence: awaiting end of the stamping out
