Consultation request to determine the novel food status of Coffee (Coffea arabica) grounds oil extract.

Name and description of the novel food:

The request concerns Coffee (*Coffea arabica*) grounds oil extract, which is intended to be used as a component of dietary supplements, possibly as a fortifying agent for some suitable foods (confectionery). Coffee grounds oil extract is taken alone or in capsule form.

Coffee grounds oil extract is a by-product of coffee and coffee beverage production. It is a black liquid with an oily consistency. It has a characteristic coffee flavor with a coffee aroma.

Coffee oil is produced by conventional extraction technology, but the production process involves the use of 'non-standard waste raw material' SCG, which was not used for food production in the Union before 15 May 1997, therefore this coffee oil can also be included in the NF Art. 3(2)(a)(iv)(vii) category.
