






Wild boar management Contracts with hunters

- In 2018 we have one big contract with Estonian Hunters` Society for selective female hunting and carcass collection and sampling:
 - By the end of August:
 - 995 hunted females wild boars
 - 16 carcass burials
 - 233 carcasses taken to containers

Farm controls – spring 2018

- Carried out by animal health specialists from county veterinary centre
- Total number of farms inspected: 132, from which 128 kept pigs.
- Purpose of the farm controls
 - Inspect if compulsory biosecurity measures are implemented correctly (feed, biosecurity plan, disinfection barrier etc)
- 16 farms received precept, mainly because of disinfection barrier and efficiency
- After the follow-up inspection all pig farms complied with requirements from the law.
