

2024

- 121 hunted wild boar
- 431 found dead wild boar

In total: 299 ADIS notifications / 552 affected wild boars

ASF in Lithuania in domestic pigs


One ASF outbreaks in 2024

2024/06/13 – outbreak was confirmed in non-commercial farm (3 pigs).

On the same day killed and destroyed on the farm territory.

In the protection and surveillance zones, 6 non-commercial pig farms keeping approx. 1-8 pigs per farm

The nearest ASF-positive boar was found approx. 10 km away from the infected farm







ASF outbreak in Lithuania 2024

- On 12 June 2024, the owner observed that one out of three pigs had suddenly died. On the same day, the owner informed a private veterinarian and the regional SFVS.
- The private veterinarian took samples from the pig within the framework of the ASF surveillance programme.
- A temporary restriction on the farm was set immediately on the day of suspicion.

- ASF was confirmed using RT-PCR on 13 June 2024
- Restriction zones on the farm was set immediately on the day of confirmation
- All measures were implemented according to Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687 of 17 December 2019 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and the Council, as regards rules for the prevention and control of certain listed diseases.








ASF in Lithuania in domestic pigs
