

ASF epidemiological situation in Latvia - 2024 (update)



Wild porcine animals cases in 2024 (to 10 July)



In total 704 ASF cases in wild porcine animals (155 hunted, 549 found dead)



Outbreak No 3. ADIS LV-ASF-2024-00335

Small farm - 24 captive porcine animals

Suspicion: 23.06.2024 (notified by the farmer)

Confirmed: 25.06.2024

Measures performed:


- Epid investigation
- Depopulation
- Primary disinfection
- Cleaning and disinfection ongoing

Outbreak in ASF affected area.

No direct contacts with wild boar were identified.

No contacts or links to outbreak No 1 (LV-ASF-2024-00322)

Restricted zone 3 already established.





Outbreak No 4. ADIS LV-ASF-2024-00376

Backyard farm – 2 captive porcine animals (fatteners)

Suspicion: 4.07.2024 (notified by the vet)


Confirmed: 5.07.2025

- Depopulation
- Primary disinfection
- Cleaning and disinfection


Outbreak in ASF affected area.


No direct contacts with wild boar were identified.
