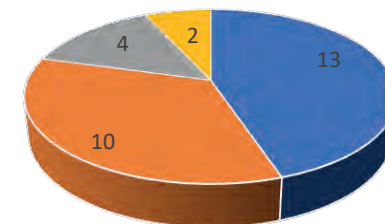

AFFECTED HOLDINGS

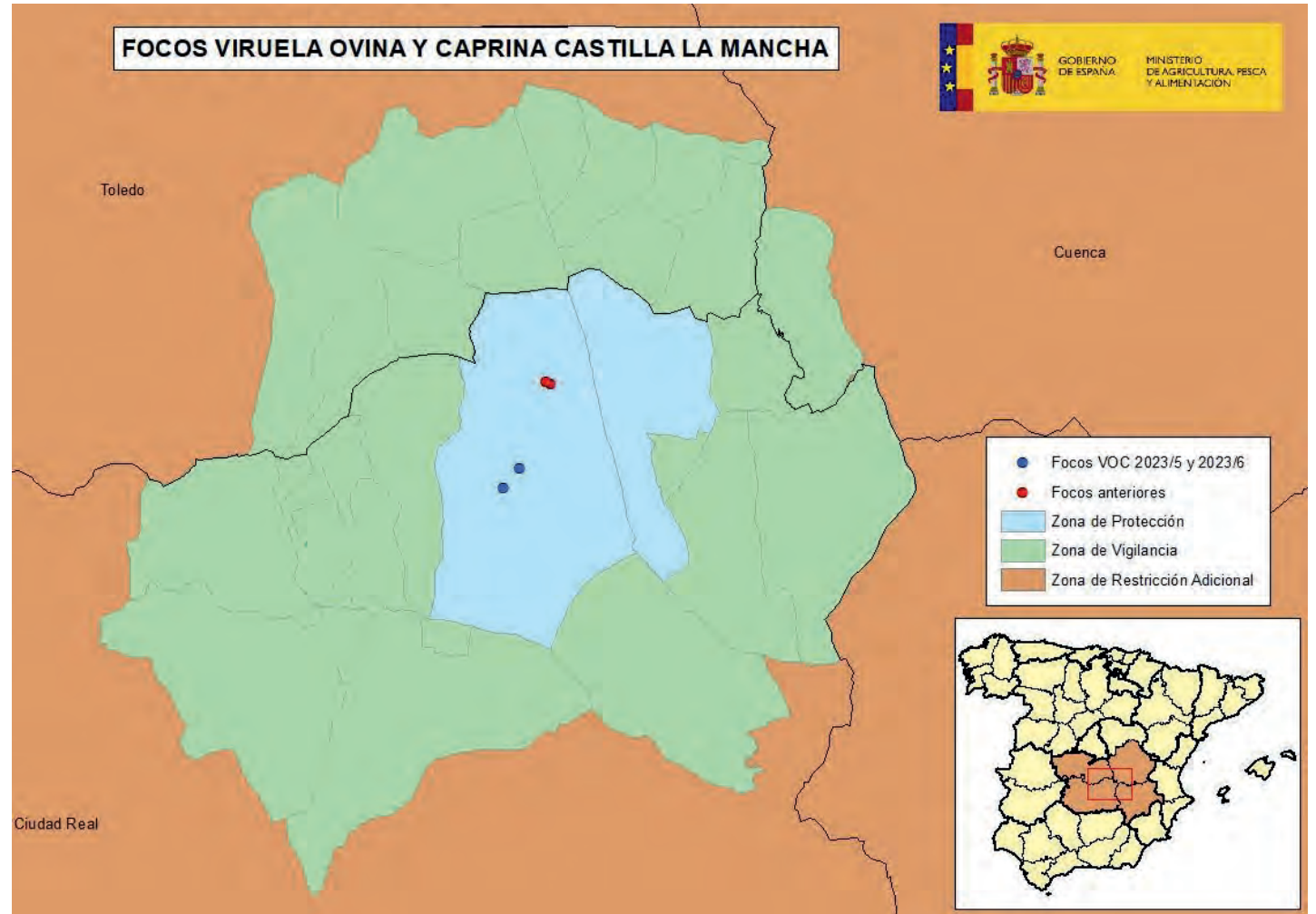


Total affected census: 51,444 sheep & 740 goats.

New outbreaks in Castilla-La Mancha

- Since last PAFF Committee, detection of 2 new outbreaks, **2023/5 & 6**, on 30/03 and 10/04 in the Municipality of **Alcázar de San Juan**, in the **province of Ciudad Real**.
- **Milk farms** with a census of **1,410 sheep (2023/5)** and **3,142 sheep & 260 goats (2023/6)**.
- Outbreaks detected by **detection of compatible skin lesions**.
- **No movements of risk from the new outbreaks**, as they were located within previous RZ of outbreaks 2023/3 & 4.
- **Epidemiological investigation ongoing**, but it is suspected in both cases connection with previous outbreaks by non-well C&D trucks.
- Adoption of the **Restricted Zone**, with a **Protection Zone** of municipalities in 10 km (44d, until 31st May) and a **Surveillance Zone** of municipalities in 30 km (59d, until 15th June)



Enhanced control measures in CLM

- Maintenance of the **Further Restricted Zone (FRZ)** to the entire territory of **Castilla - La Mancha**, except for the province of **Guadalajara**, applicable until **13st July**.
- **Movements only to slaughterhouses only within zones (PZ-PZ; SZ-SZ) and from FRZ to free zone.**
- Before these movements: **clinical inspection of animals to be moved at least 24 hours before + check of C&D conditions of vehicles + sealing of trucks.**
- **Enhancement of biosecurity.** C&D controls in slaughterhouses.
- **Enhanced active surveillance**, with official visit, clinical inspection and sampling of salivary swabs (2% prevalence, 95% confidence) in all those farms with any epi link with detected outbreaks.
- **Enhanced post-mortem inspection in SH operating in the areas.**



Enhanced control measures in CLM

- **Awareness: meetings of the OVS with farmers and sheep and goat sector associations** in different Municipalities of Castilla – la Mancha, aimed at increasing awareness on the disease, biosecurity and passive surveillance → **Important Media coverage** of the meetings at regional and national level.
- **Active monitoring of Kg of ovine animals removed from ovine and caprine CLM herds.**
- **Intensification of collaboration with SEPRONA and road police** (increase the presence in the area, road controls on animal movements vehicles, controls on C&D of vehicles, etc.).



Conclusions



- Detection of **new outbreaks** (2023/5 & 6) in the municipality of Alcázar de San Juan, in the province of Ciudad Real in Castilla – La Mancha. **Epidemiological link suggests accidental infection from non properly cleaned trucks involved in outbreaks 2023/4, 5 and 6.**
- Adoption of new control measures of SGPV in the area:
 - ✓ Expansion of PZ and SZ both in space and time → New zoning includes **PZ of municipalities in 10 km for 44 days (until May 31st) and SZ of municipalities in 30 km for 59 days (until June 15th).** The FRZ will be implemented until July 31st.
 - ✓ Strict measures related to animal movements: **clinical inspection of animals to be moved at least 24 hours prior-movement + control of C&D conditions of the trucks + sealing of trucks.**
- So far, 32.412 samples have been analysed in the NRL from sheep and goats holdings in CLM under enhanced surveillance.
