## **Outbreaks in Pleven region**

#### Outbreak #1 – Zhernov village

- Date of suspicion: 02.07.2019
- Date of confirmation: 03.07.2019
- Location: Zhernov village, municipality of Nikopol, Pleven
- ADNS notification: 03.07.2019, 18:55
- Backyard with 14 pigs (2+2 dead)







## **Possible sources of infection**

Mechanically through contaminated vehicles/people – most possible:

-located on a transit road with Ro with trucks passing -equipment and vehicles of the owner-agri producer (poor biosec on entrance)

-visitors (including private vet and hunter)

- Direct contact with WB well fenced premises, but no external fence on the back of the yard bordering with a field
- Feed unlikely no swill-feeding, own-crop produced feed
- Illegal animal movement to the holding unlikely no new animals introduced in the past months


### **Outbreaks in Pleven region**

#### Outbreak #2 – Novachene village

- Date of suspicion: 04.07.2019
- Date of confirmation: 05.07.2019
- Location: Novachene village, municipality of Nikopol, Pleven
- ADNS notification: 05.07.2019, 16:22
- Backyard with 2 pigs (1 dead, 1 sick)
- 11 km distance from outbreak #1

#### Source of infection:

- No evidence of direct epi-link with outbreak #1 so far
- Possible mechanical introduction
- Epi-investigation ongoing...



## Measures enforced - 1

- 3 and 10-km zones
- Culling of all domestic pigs in the 3-km protection zones
- Cleansing and disinfection
- Clinical and examinations and sampling in the 10-km zones
- Disinfection posts and vehicle checks



## Measures enforced - 2


- Clinical examinations in entire Pleven region
- Checks for illegal movement
- Ban of animal markets and exhibitions of pigs
- Epi-commissions in all high-risk regions
- Movement of pigs no possibility for movement at this stage from 3 and 10-km zones (1 type A family farm in 10-km zone), in Pleven region – movement regimen set out in ordinance by BFSA and in line with CID (EU) 2014/709 (i.e. pre-movement testing of each batch – only option) – possible only for commercial farms

### Cases/outbreaks and Regionalization (situation as by 05 July 2019)



- Cases in WB
- Outbreaks in domestic pigs
- Regionalization according to the Annex of CID 2014/709 (Part I, Part II, Part III)
- Industrial Farms
- Active WB searching in Zones 2-20 KM and Zones 20-40 KM around WB cases
