#### Overview

This report was produced through the EU-funded H2020 project REFRESH (Resource Efficient Food and Drink for the Entire Supply Chain) and records the progress of four European countries (Hungary, Germany, the Netherlands, and Spain) in the establishment of Frameworks for Action to tackle food waste along the whole supply chain.

The report focuses on the first twenty months of the Refresh project (July 2015 to February 2017). It begins with a summary of the purpose of this work, and goes on to explain what is meant by a Framework Agreement (FA) within the context of REFRESH. The report continues with four Country Reports, providing standalone accounts of each country's progress through key stages

In the Netherlands there was an existing high level platform of business and private sector actors. We were able to tap into this to create a working group of those most relevant to the objectives of our FA. Some advice would be to check out if such a platform exists in your country.

We first identified the mix of business and government and other stakeholders we wanted to involve. Then we had a series of bilateral discussions with each one to find out about their priorities and whether they would participate in such an agreement.
