


Berlin, Brandenburg,
Mecklenburg-Western
Pomerania, Saxony and
Saxony-Anhalt are five of the
16 Laender of the Federal
Republic of Germany.

BHV1 is a notifiable disease since 1997 (Federal Ordinance)

BHV1-plan started on 1 March 2004 in all *Laender* (Article 9-regions)

14 Laender are listed in Annex I of the Decision 2004/558/EC with the exception of Bavaria and Thuringia (Annex II – Decision 2014/703/EC of 08.10.2014).






Total number of bovine animals in the five *Laender* (as of 31.12.2013):

-dairy cattle and suckler

cows: 1,850,637 -holdings: 14,042

Distributed to 13 towns and 41 rural districts





Eradication of BHV1-infection in Berlin, Brandenburg, Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania, Saxony and Saxony-Anhalt

- start on a voluntary basis in early 1990: vaccination of all bovine animals with deleted gE-Markervaccine
- Mandatory since 1997 (Federal Ordinance): vaccination (deleted gE-Markervaccine) and selection of gE-seropositive bovine animals (slaughtered/killed)
- Identification and registration of all gE-seropositive bovine animals in the Bovine Central Database (HIT)
- Documentation of all vaccinations and results of investigations in HIT
- Until 31 December 2014: all gE-seropositive bovine animals have been removed from their holdings
- Since 10 January 2014:
 - vaccination prohibited
 - only BHV-1 seronegative, not-vaccinated bovine animals are allowed to move at the holdings (certificate)



Ongoing measures

- •Official control of the competent authority of all BHV1-free holdings according to the BHV1- Federal Ordinance (bovine animals >24 months of age, at least once every 12 months)
- Detected seropositive bovine animals are to be killed/slaughtered immediately (official order)
- •Official control of the competent authority of the national and EC-trade of bovine animals (also with the help of HIT)
