# State of play (with competent units)

- Meat inspection (latest MS meeting on 06/10/2017)
- The first AW reference centre, on pigs (call on 16/10/2017)
- EU reference laboratories for plant health (DA + IA in 2018)

#### **Entry into the Union (G3 + G4 in charge)**

- Document sent to MS on 20 July 2017 on for instance:
  - List of animals and goods (incl CN codes) to BCPs
  - Derogation from certain BCP requirements

# Outcome of Member States meeting 27 October 2017 on "Entry into the EU"

- the timing when Competent Authorities can expect first ideas from the Commission

General agreement to proceed with multi-layer communication channels (CVOs, CPHOs, HoA...)

### **Approach to consultations**

- Each empowerment will be discussed with Member States (expert and working groups);
- 2) Once consensus is reached on preliminary ideas, the COM will consult the SANTE advisory group on major initiatives (DA & IA);
- 3) COM will consolidate the draft and notify the SANTE advisory group the progresses;
- 4) The DA/IA is sent to EP/Council: start of the scrutiny period (where applicable)





# 3. Next steps

- 15 December 2017 with Member States: follow-up discussion on import controls;
- Temptative ad-hoc stakeholder meeting on import controls during the 1 quarter of 2018;
- Provisional calendar of meetings with Member States.
