Regarding your e-mail on Romania's TSE monitoring and eradication program for the year 2012, we communicate the following:

- Regarding the testing target on group sheep not slaughtered for human consumption, we would like to clarify the following aspects:
- the proposed number of tests to be done in 2012 on target group ovine not slaughtered for human consumption, was set taking in account the actual tests made by Romania in previous years on this category.
- Romania has realized a realist estimate, as much as possible, of tests number that will be done in 2012 at this category, so we'll not ask for large amounts of money, which will remain unused and will not be used in other purposes by blocking them, given the fact that we've often received observations on this issue.
- it was taken into account that in case of testing of a larger number of animals then it was foreseen in the program, supplementary funds will be asked in September when usually programs' budget adjustment takes place.
- also, we mention that Romania has done and does efforts to increase tests number on ovine from target group not-slaughtered for human consumption. For 2012 were set testing targets for each county from Romania according to ovine population over 18 months and taking in

NSVFSA oversees, by monthly checks, the achievement grade of these targets, so by the end of the year, Romania should accomplish the requirements of 999/2001 Regulations by realizing a minimum sample of 10.000 tests.

 the same procedure of setting the targets for each county will be used also in 2012, Romania overseeing the substantial increase of tests number by finding solutions in collecting dead bodies of ovine.

Like you suggest, we entered in the program project, the execution of 10.000 tests on target group ovine not slaughtered for human consumption.

Regarding the tests proposed by Romania for ovine slaughtered for human consumption, the Regulation (EC) no. 999/2001 provides in Annex III, point II, 2, (a) that "Member States in which the population of ewes and even tembs put to the ram experient 75/1000 animals shall test in accordance with the sampling rules set out in point 4 in minimum annual sample of 10 000 ovine animals slaughtered for human consumption", not telling precisely the maximum limit of the sample.

We mention that Romania, taking in account the growing number of animals positive diagnosed in 2010, has took the decision of implementing in 2011 the testing of all ovine over 18 months, both for target group ovine slaughtered for human consumption, as well as for target group ovine notslaughtered for human consumption, as supplementary measure in order not to miss animals that could be diagnosed with scrapie.

Taking in account that Regulation (EC) no. 999/2001 doesn't provide a maximum sample of tests that should be tested, we kindly ask you to communicate why the tests done over the minimum sample of 10.000 tests, wouldn't be eligible for co-financing.

2. We mention that the PHARE program, of which Romania has benefit, closed in 2010, all the tests that will be done in 2011, will be done only from budgetary funds, as Romania won't be benefitting from other financed program from other EU funds.

The Romanian authorities estimation is realistic as much as possible, based on the bovines, ovines and caprines population, as well as on tests number done during the previous years on

We mention that we have eliminated from the program the tests made on cervids, which are not eligible for financing.

We send you the project of the program on TSE s for 2012, with the changes mentioned above.

Romania plan for the prevention and monitoring of Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopaty (EST)

2012

Preamble

The objective of the plan is that of establishing additional measures for the prevention of bovine spongiform encephalopaty (BSE), scrapia and chronic wasting disease (CWD) in chervils appearance, as well as for monitoring the epidemiological situation in Romania in order to detect in time and eradicate these diseases at bovine, ovine and caprine animals.

The plan has at the basis:

- decision 2009/470/CE (background decision) from the date of 29.05.2009 and
- decision 425/2008/CE (standard requirements of Communities) from the data of 25.04.2008

The Surveillance, control, and monitoring of the domestic bovines, ovines, and caprines and of the ruminants from the silvan environment and in captivity

The Surveillance, control, and monitoring of ruminant flocks for TSE makes the objective "The programme for the actions of surveillance, prevention and control of animal diseases, of those transmissible from animals to man, for protection of animals and environment" which is carried out yearly by the National Sanitary Veterinary and for Food Safety Authority; this programme is suplimented, everytime it is necessary, with epidemiological and risk analysis.

The Surveillance of animal flocks for TSE by laboratory examinations has at the basis the provisions of Regulation 999/2001 regarding the establishing of the prevention, control, eradication rules of the transmissible spongiform encephalopaties.

Plan Romania TSE 2012 Revizia 0 din data de 12.08.2011 Data trimiterii catre CE: 12.08.2011 During carring out the programmes, the competent authority has in its view the representation of the samples for each district and season, as well as the selection of the samples regarding the species, age, rase, productive type.

Yearly there is programmed a minimum number of samples which are analized for TSE according to the estimated number of animals which is provided to be slaughtered in that year and taking into account the total number of sampled tested for TSE from previsious years.

The Epidemiological Situation

1. Bovine Spongiform Encephalopaty (BSE)

The examination of the bovines for the BSE is carried out in Romania with the application of the provisions of the art. 6, indent 1 according to Annex III, Chapter A paragraph I no.2 and 3 of Regulation 999/2001 regarding the establishing of the prevention, control, eradication rules of some transmissible spongiform encephalopaties.

All the healthy bovines slaughtered for human consumption with the age over 30 months are examined, by rapid tests approved by CE, according to annex X, chapter C of Regulation 999/2001 in the edition in force and the subsequent amendments.

All the bovines with the age over 24 months which are emergency slaughtered, found sick at antemortem inspection and the dead bovines with the age over 24 months are also examined for BSE.

The epidemiological situation regarding BSE, the statistic information regarding the animal flocks in 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010 the number of animals which were slaughtered normaly, the number of the dead animals, the number of animals which were emergency slaughtered and found sick at antemortem inspection, the number of samples taken and the results in 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010 are presented in the annex no 1.

The results of the active and passive surveillance activity for BSE, the monitoring of the bovine flocks, the clinical and laboratory investigations undertaken up to the present did not show the presence of bovine spongiform encephalopaty in Romania.

In the year 2005 there were examined for BSE a number of 55,414 bovines covering all eligible categories for testing from a total population of 2,421,685 of bovines.

In the year 2007 there were examined for BSE a number of 132,682 bovines covering all eligible categories for testing from a total population of 3.762,708 of bovines.

In the year 2008 there were examined for BSE a number of 131,482 bovines covering all eligible categories for testing from a total population of 2,326,832 of bovines.

In the year 2009 there were examined for BSE a number of 73.381 bovines covering all eligible categories for testing from a total population of 2.254.190 of bovines.

In the year 2009 there were examined for BSE a number of 79.190 bovines covering all eligible categories for testing from a total population of 4.007.482 of bovines.

Per total, in Romania between 2001- 2010 there were examined for BSE a number of 734.632 bovines which had a negative result at the BSE test.

2. Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopaties (TSE) at the small ruminants

The Surveillance, control, and monitoring of small ruminant flocks for scrapia are accomplished according to the provisions of "The programme for the actions of surveillance, prevention and control of animal diseases, of those transmissible from animals to man, for protection of animals and environment carried out yearly by the National Sanitary Veterinary and for Food Safety Authority under the provisions of Regulation 999/2001 and the national legislation Community adapted. The epidemiological situation regarding scrapia, the statistic information regarding animal flocks, the number of slaughtered and dead animals, and the number of the samples taken, scrapia outbreaks and the number of diagnosed and confirmed animals are presented in the *annex no.1* and *annex no.2*.

The examination of ovines and caprines to identify the presence of scrapia is carried out in Romania according to the provisions of Article 6, paragraph 1 according to Annex III Chapter A paragraph II, no. 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Regulation No 999/2001 regarding the establishing of the prevention, control and eradication rules of some transmissible spongiform encephalopathies.

Scrapia was diagnosed at the National Reference Laboratory (NRL) for the first time in 2002 and confirmed by LCR VLA Weybridge, the disease being

During 2002 – 2010 the disease was notified in 16 counties, being found 58 outbreaks in which 154 diagnosed and confirmed cases were registered.

Information regarding the system in place for the identification of animals and system in place for registration of holdings are presented in *annex no.3*

Regarding the necesary of tests for BSE for bovines, scrapia for sheep and goats for 2012, we inform you that this necesary is determineed in annex III. according of Decision Commission no. 425/2008.

Number of tests requested for genotyping, the discriminatory molecular tests and the estimation of number of animals which will be killed/slaughtered following of aplication of eradication measure for scrapie in 2012 is presented in annex III.

In case of increase of number of bovines, sheeps and goats slaughtered will be over our expectations and if the epidemiologic situation will be changed or if the aditional amendments of Regulation CE no.999/2001 will impose the performing of aditional tests in comparision with our estimation, we will require supplementary funds for testing bovines, sheep and goats.
