PUBLIC CONSULTATION: <u>Between 2</u> <u>May- 30 May</u>

- 21 replies, in general **positive feedback**:
 - 13 stakeholders
 - 8 citizens opinions (3 anonymous)

List of animals diseases discussed in:

- 7 expert groups with MS (from Nov 2017 to March 2018)
- 2 CVOs meetings (Oct 2016 and Nov 2017
- 2 advisory groups AHAC (March and Dec 2017)

DOGS TRUST:

- Inclusion of Infection with Leishmania infantum, Infection with Brucella canis
 - ✓ Not priority diseases, not identified for an assessment

ORNAMENTAL FISH INTERNATIONAL (OFI) and EUROPEAN ASSOCIATION OF ZOOS AND AQUARIA (EAZA):

- Inclusion of Infection with Batrachochytrium dendrobatidis
 - ✓ Not priority diseases, not identified for an assessment

EUROPEAN ASSOCIATION OF ZOOS AND AQUARIA (EAZA):

- Separate the infection with Mycobacterium tuberculosis complex (M. bovis, M. caprae and M. tuberculosis) in 3 different animal diseases likely administrative burden, would jeopardise movements
 - √ The amended list follows the OIE approach
 - ✓ Exceptions foreseen in the act on movements and on surveillance

EUROPEAN ASSOCIATION OF ZOOS AND AQUARIA (EAZA):

 Exclusion of LPAI for captive birds and wild animals

- ✓ Already listed (currently equivalent to category A),
- ✓ The amended list "downscales" the disease
- ✓ Special rules and exceptions foreseen in the act on movements and on surveillance

EUROPEAN ASSOCIATION OF ZOOS AND AQUARIA (EAZA): EUROPEAN ASSOCIATION OF ZOO AND WILDLIFE VETERINARIANS

- narrow down the listing to yellow head virus genotype 1.
 - ✓ Clarification (by the EURL): 'Yellow Head Virus' means genotype 1
 - √ genotype 2 is named "gill associated virus" GAV,
 - √ the remaining 6 genotypes no name



COPA COGECA FESASS

- request information on categorisation of animal diseases
 - √ different legal acts decided by co-legislators
 - ✓ IA laying down categories of animal diseases will be available for stakeholders consultation

FESASS

- Surprised surra on the list
 - ✓ Surra fulfilled the criteria, following the expertise from Member States experts (non-consensus from EFSA)

FESASS

- listed diseases "E" diseases: funds for surveillance
 - ✓ Different level of surveillance foreseen depending on the disease
 - ✓ AHL only related to control measures and its scope does not cover financial aspects
- What would happen with porcine epidemic diarrhoea (PED)?
 - ✓ PED never listed, just temporary measures for imports were laid down which are not in force now
 - ✓ Permanent preventive rule for blood and blood products is in place
