1. ANALYSIS OF THE MAJOR DEFICIENCIES DETECTED DURING THE NON-DISCRIMINATORY INSPECTIONS

For the purpose of this annual report, the following have been considered to be major deficiencies:

1. Animals unfit for transport at arrival in slaughterhouse
2. Documentation: transport licences/certificates not available; no (correct) transport documents.
3. Violations of transport and resting times cattle. Transport too long and/or no resting time/resting time too long (to comply with driver's regulations)

2. ACTION PLAN TO ADDRESS THE DEFICIENCIES DESCRIBED UNDER POINT 1.

In general: continue (risk-based) inspections and enforcement;

Ad 1. In 2016, extra checks and enforcement are foreseen at all parts of the chain: transport, assembly centres and slaughterhouses.

Ad 2. Continue checks and enforcement

Ad 3. Enforcement in 2014-2015 has resulted in a decrease of non-compliances. It is no longer one of the higher priorities but checks will remain on a base line level.
