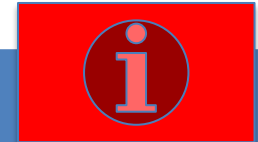
# Part II of the DWD: Title I



- Transporters subject for registration:
  - Poultry
  - Dogs, cats and ferrets
  - Kept terrestrial animals other than ungulates



## • Establishments subject to approval:



AHL	
• Assembly operations of kept ungulates and poultry	• Assembly centres for dogs, cats and ferrets
• Hatcheries	• Animal shelters for dogs, cats and ferrets
• Breeding poultry	• <i>Control posts</i>
• Confined establishments	• Environmentally isolated bumble bee production
	• Quarantine for kept terrestrial animals



- Requirements for granting approval concerning, where appropriate:
  - Quarantine, isolation and biosecurity measures
  - Surveillance of diseases
  - Facilities and equipment
  - Personnel on the establishment
  - CA's supervision

- Registers to be kept by CA's:

- Additional record-keeping obligations of operators

General record-keeping obligations:	Additional record-keeping obligations: 
Operators keeping terrestrial animals: Article 102(1) of AHL	Obligation to maintain up-to-date records on information relevant to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ Assessing the animal health status</li><li>✓ Traceability</li></ul>
Operators of hatcheries: Article 103(1) of AHL	
Transporters: Article 104(1) of AHL	
Operators conducting assembly operations: Article 105(1)	





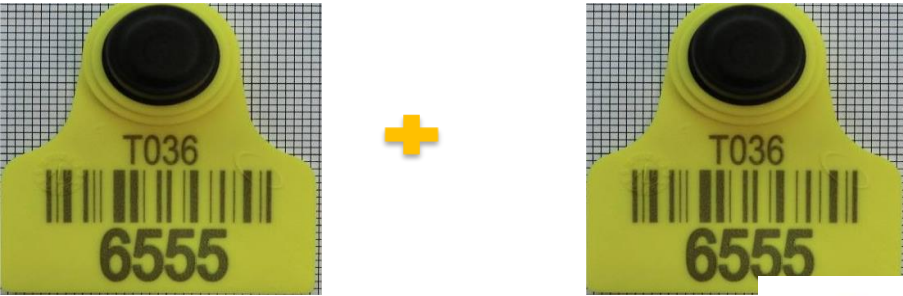

- Exemptions: bovines kept for cultural, scientific, historical or sporting (*or hobby*) purposes- permitted by MS



# Part III of the DWD




- Basic rule
  - Slaughter animals <12 months old, at least:

Within MS



Directly to another MS slaughterhouse



- Non-slaughter animals:

- *Exemption and special rule:*
- **animals kept for cultural or scientific (or hobby) purposes- permitted by MS**



OR



- **MS with low population within its territory:**

- ✓ Ovine+caprine <600 000
- ✓ Caprine <160 000

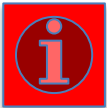

**No ID** within MS for movements within supply change- permission by MS

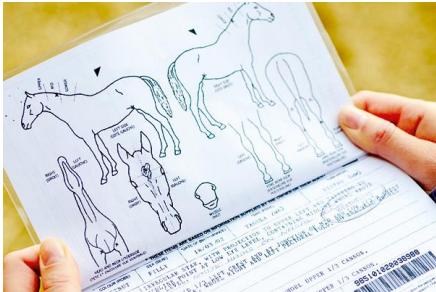
- porcine kept for cultural or scientific (or hobby) purposes- permitted by MS

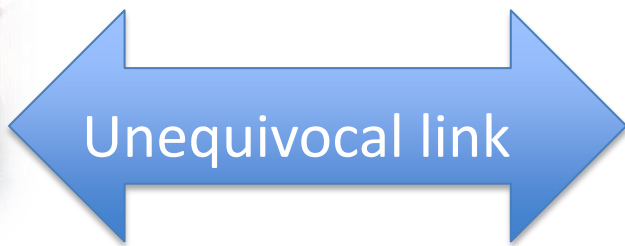

## When animals are moved to another MS



- Rules applicable by Regulation (EU) No 576/2013 shall continue to apply until 21 April 2026- Part VI of AHL

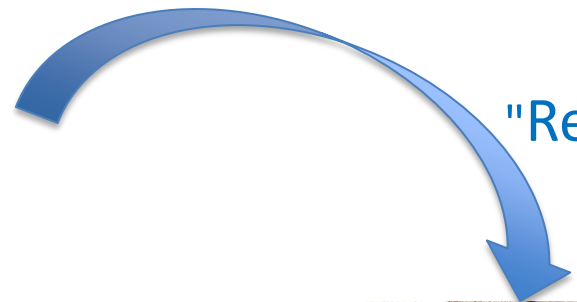
