

**Analysis of major deficiencies detected during the non-discriminatory inspections and action plan to address them  
as provided for in Article 27(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1/2005**

## **1. ANALYSIS OF THE MAJOR DEFICIENCIES DETECTED DURING THE NON-DISCRIMINATORY INSPECTIONS**

**For the purpose of this annual report, the following have been considered to be major deficiencies:**

By comparing non-discriminatory inspection data carried out in accordance with Council Regulation (EC) No. 1/2005, which were carried out during 2017. compared to 2016 the number of non-discriminatory inspections was reduced by 44.00 %, and the total number of identified deficiencies was increased by 283,61 %.

By analyzing data on non-discriminatory inspections carried out in accordance with Council Regulation (EC) No. 1/2005 which were carried out during 2017. in comparison to 2016 it has been found that the number of non-compliance related to the journey log referred in Article 5. and Annex II, on the certificates of qualification for drivers and road vehicle accompanying vehicles referred to Article 17. regulation (EC) 1/2005 to the certificate of approval of means of transport referred to Article 18. of Regulation (EC) No. 1/2005 and non-compliance of the certificate with the shipment for was increased by 305,26 %. The above mentioned deficiencies have been identified as the largest number of non-conformities found by non-discriminatory inspections.

## **2. ACTION PLAN TO ADDRESS THE DEFICIENCIES DESCRIBED UNDER POINT 1.**

We determined by analysis of the major deficiencies that the number of non-compliance was increased in regarding the journey log, the certificates of qualification for drivers and road vehicle accompanying vehicles and the certificate of approval of means of transport

Directorate of Veterinary and Food Safety identified the activities to be undertaken:

- Increase the frequency of non-discriminatory inspections of transporters who did not comply with the provisions of Regulation (EC) 1/2005 in respect of the non-conformities relating to the log of the journeys referred to Article 5. and Annex II, certificates for drivers and road vehicle accompanying vehicles referred to Article 17. of Regulation (EC) 1/2005 and certificate of approval for means of transport with referred to Article 18 of Regulation (EC) No. 1/2005 and non-compliance of the certificate with the shipment.
- Increasing of frequencies of official controls in accordance with risk assessment will be written in Annual plan of official controls
