



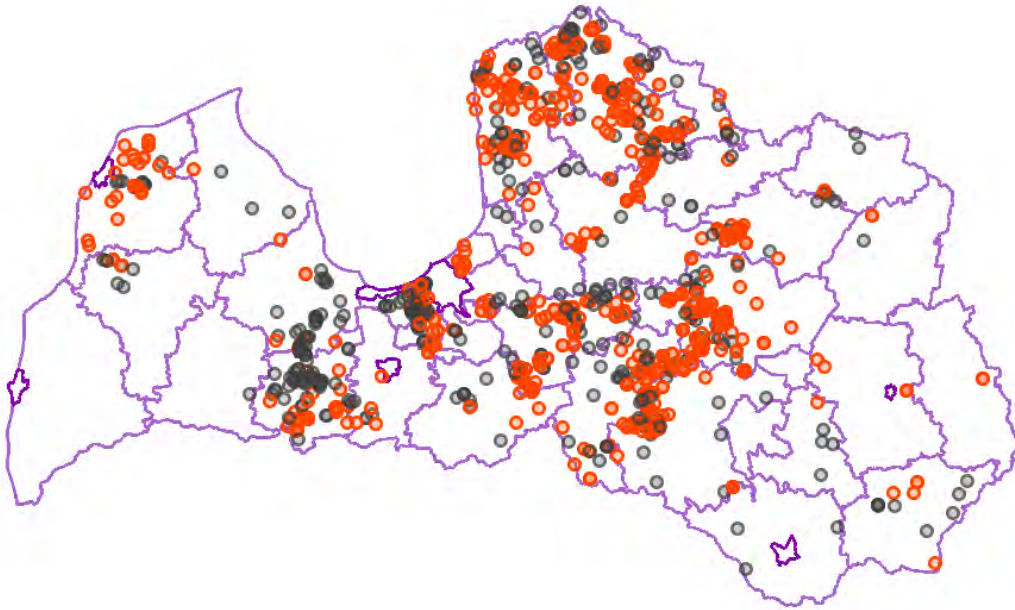

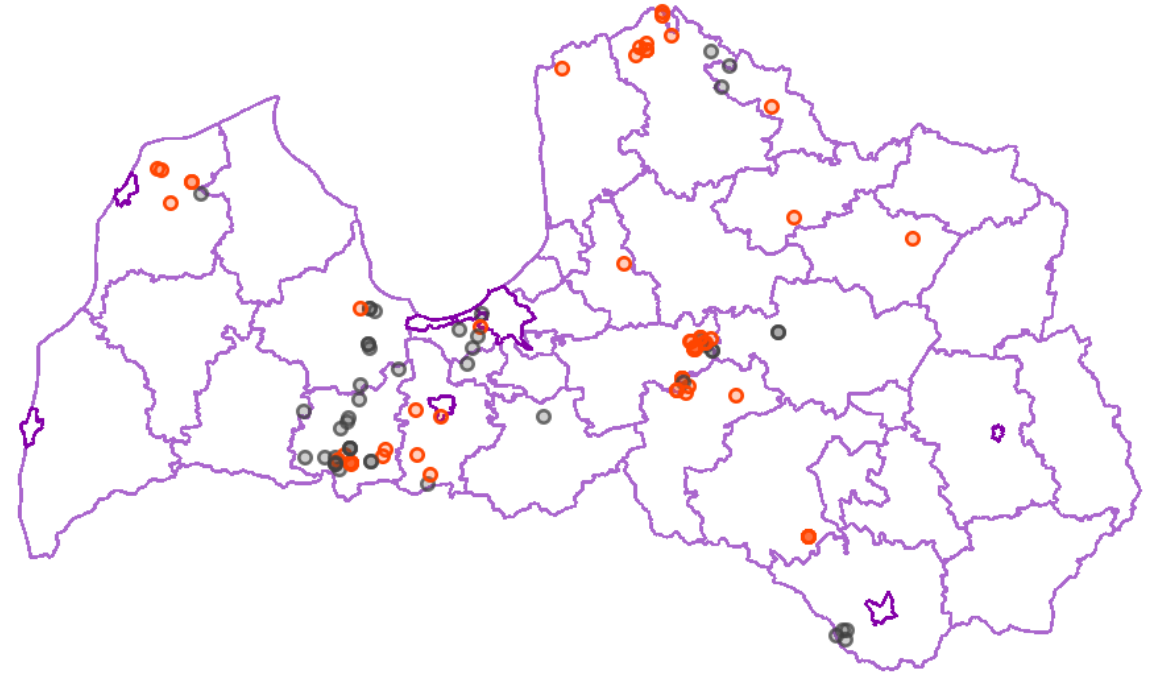


# ASF in Wild porcine animals – 2024 and 2025 (16 January)



- Found dead
- Hunted

In total **1408** ASF cases in wild porcine animals  
(432 hunted, 976 found dead)



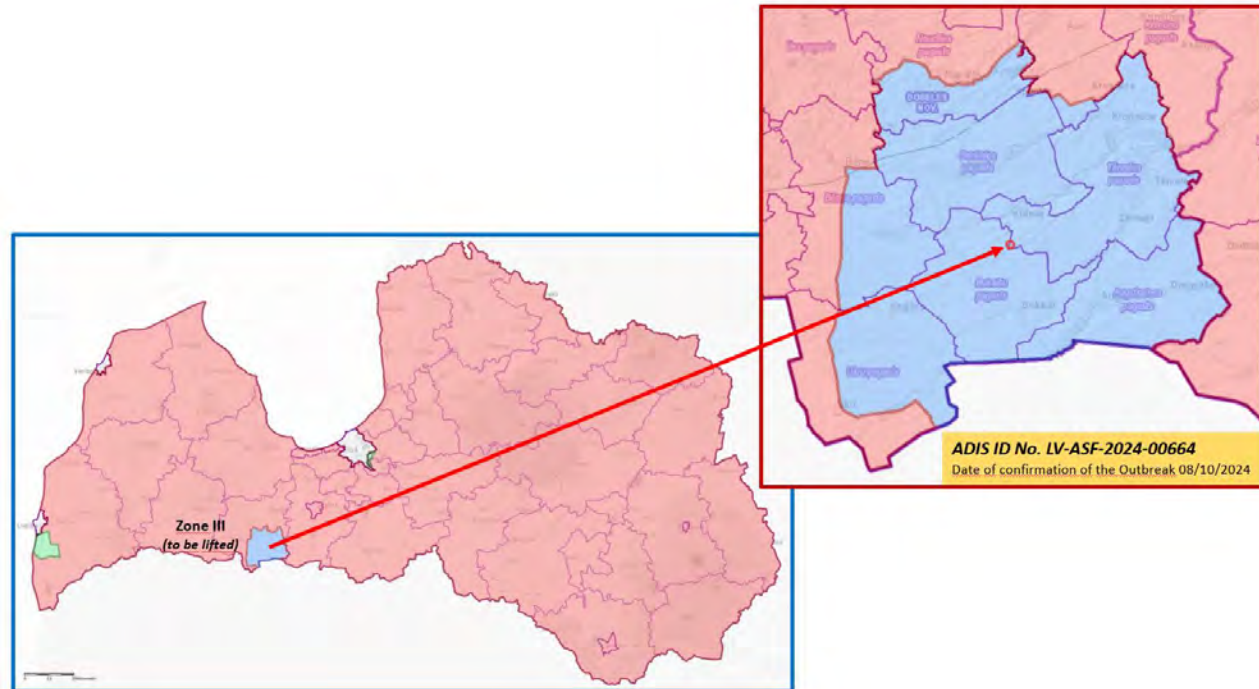
In total **107** ASF cases in wild porcine animals  
(47 hunted, 60 found dead)

# Application for reverting certain areas of RZ3 to RZ2

Based on the Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687 and according to Commission notice on the guidelines on the prevention, control, and eradication of African swine fever in the Union ('ASF guidelines') C/2023/1504:

- No further ASF outbreaks detected in kept porcine animal establishments in these territories since 8th October 2024
- The results of measures referred to in Articles 26 and 41 (visits by the official veterinarians and clinical and when necessary, laboratory examinations) of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687 implemented.
- The scientific assessment carried out at EU or national level demonstrate no evidence of presence of *Ornithodoros* ticks in Latvia.
- Passive surveillance system for establishments of kept porcine animals is implemented;
- Active and passive surveillance for wild porcine animals are implemented.
