1. BACKGROUND



Reminder - <u>Single Market Programme</u>

- New Multi-annual Financial Framework for 2021-2027
- New legal base adopted on 28 April 2021: Regulation (EU) 2021/690 establishing a programme for the internal market, competitiveness of enterprises, including small and medium-sized enterprises, the area of plants, animals, food and feed, and European statistics (**SMP** Regulation)
- Administrative simplification with the adoption of a single work programme for all the activities related to the Food Chain
- Exception for Vet/Phyto programmes that require an early adoption for allowing the submission of National programmes by 31 May (N-1)
- Transitional provisions with retroactivy for eligible costs in 2021-2022

2. WORK PROGRAMME 2023



Multi-annual work programme

- Multi-annual financing decision (2023-2024)
- Implementation by HaDEA Health and Digital Executive Agency
- Programme content has evolved compared to 2021-2022 :

Veterinary Programme

- Third countries competent authorities explicitely quoted as possible designated beneficiaries
- Bluetongue in small ruminants not anymore co-financed
- End of co-financing for bovine tuberculosis in 2024

Phytosanitary Programme

- Revision of the pest priority groups
- Transfer of budget if fewer applications submitted
