# Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/999

# Article 5(2) of Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/999

• Each Member State shall establish, based on the technical requirements and specifications for marking set out in Part 1 of the Annex, rules concerning the characteristics and form of the marking of straws and other packages, in which the germinal products are placed, stored and transported, used in its territory and it shall transmit that information to the Commission and to the other Member States

#### Information submitted by EU countries, Norway and Switzerland

According to Regulation (EU) 2016/1012 of the European Parliament and the Council and Council Directive 90/428/EEC Member States shall draw up, keep up-to-date and make available certain information to the public in the zootechnical field, in particular in relation to competent authorities performing official controls, recognised breed societies and breeding operations, approved breeding programmes and equine competitions.
