

blue: HPAI-negative




#### Non-poultry

- 1 outbreak in a small backyard flock : Upper Austria, district of Braunau
  - Confirmation on 04.10.2024: H5N1
  - Mixed flock: chicken, geese, pheasants
  - Measures according to Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687
  - Exception from zoning in these outbreaks of non-poultry backyard flocks
  - All measures lifted

#### **Poultry**

- 1 outbreak: Upper Austria, district of Braunau reported at PAFF in October
  - Confirmation on 09.10.2024: H5N1
  - 75 chickens, 22 turkeys, 16 ducks and 12 guinea fowl
  - All measures lifted






• One protection zone (r = 6,8 km) and one surveillance (r = 13,8 km) zone for outbreaks 2, 3, 4 and 6





### **Outbreaks per week**

- Area with high risk: all Austria
- Area with very high risk: will be amended due to new outbreaks in wild birds in Lower Austria and Burgenland
  - Biosecurity has to be increased
  - Obligatory indoor-keeping of all birds in holdings with more than 50 animals (poultry)
