Since last SCoPAFF until now (21.04.2021)	161	50	211

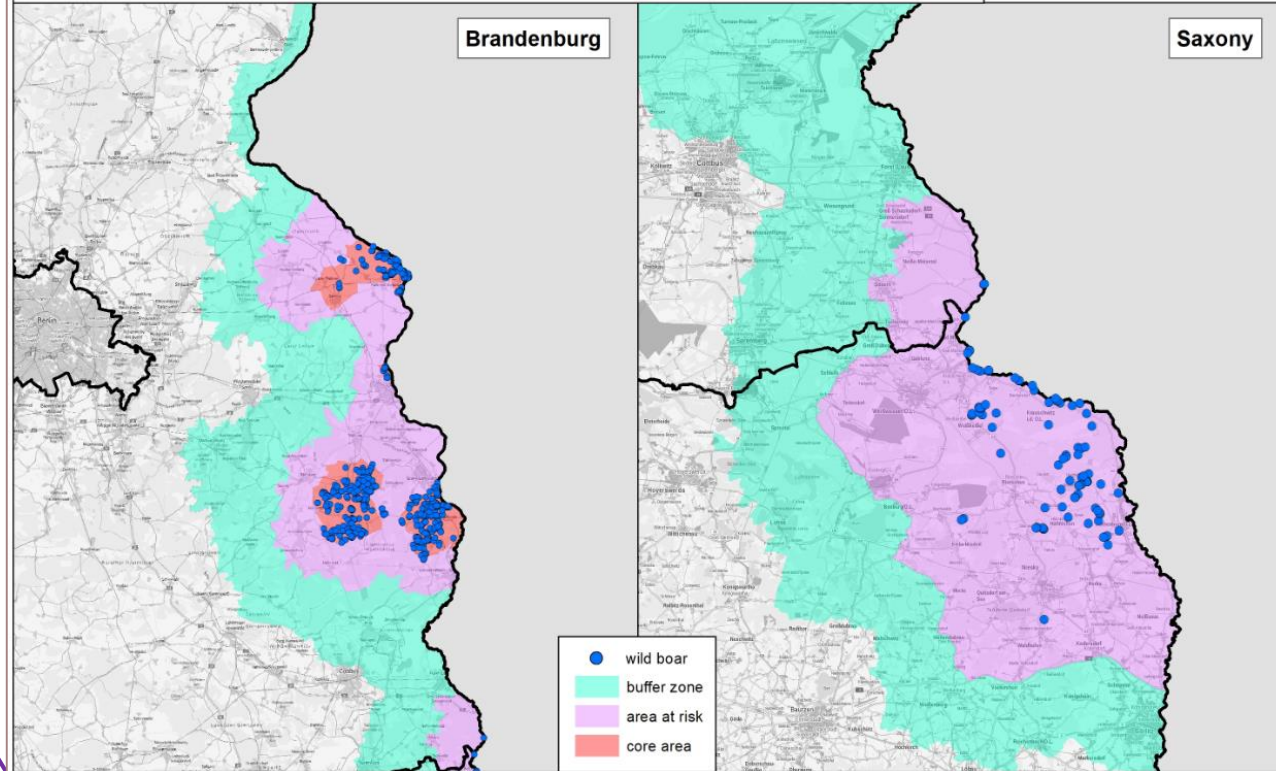

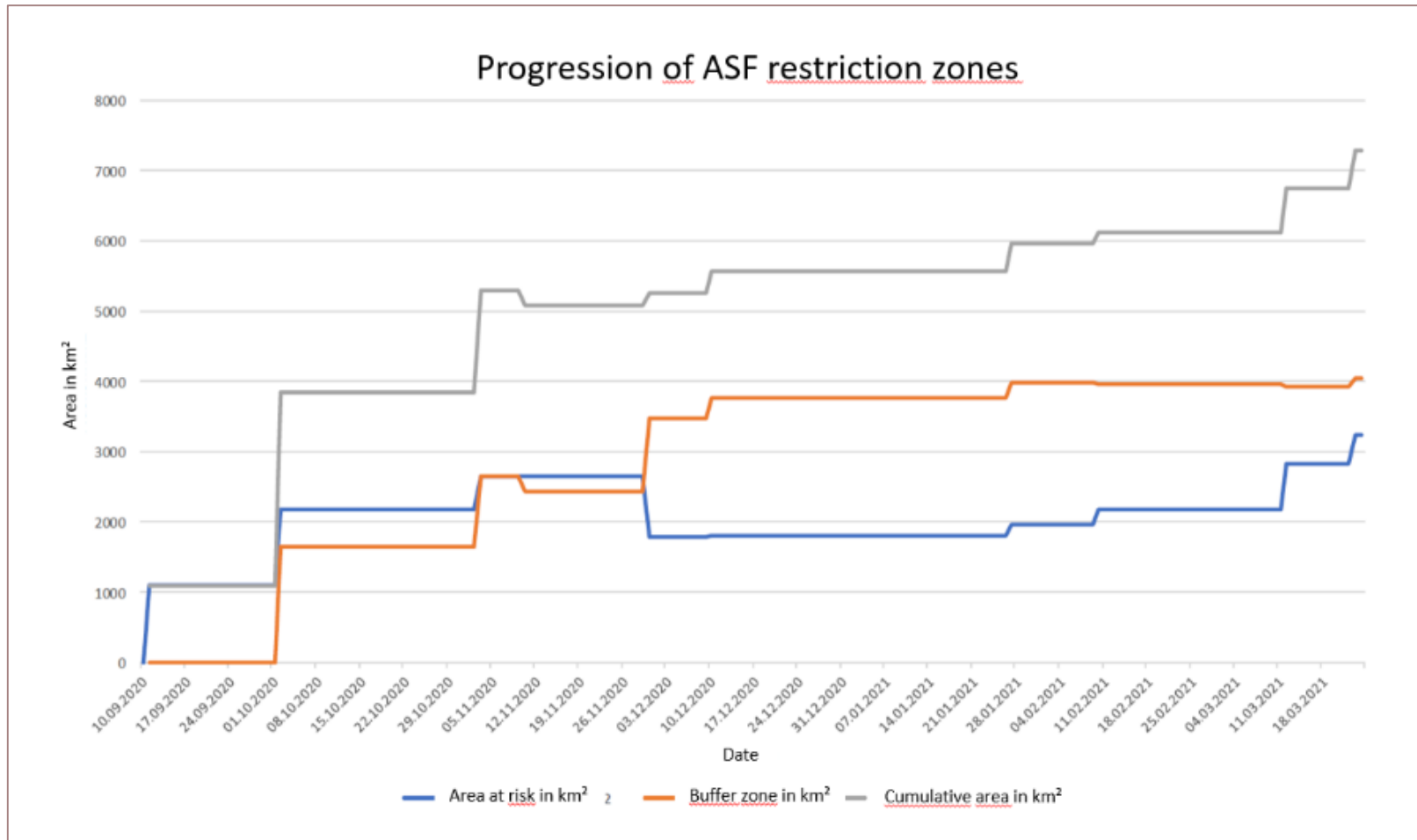
African Swine Fever positive wild boar in Brandenburg and Saxony

ASF: Measures I

Some of the ongoing measures

Brandenburg

- Enlargement of restriction zones (Märkisch Oderland)
- Building fences (zones and border)
- Carcass search (drones, dogs etc.)
- Trapping

Saxony

- Carcass search (drones, dogs etc.)
- Building and maintenance of fences
- Sampling and removal of found dead/road traffic accident carcasses
- Wild boar reduction, sampling and removal (area at risk)
- Trapping

Fences

- **Brandenburg**

Border: 240 km (15 km left due to flooding)

Total:

532 km permanent fence

+ 117 km electric/site fence

= 649 km fences (yet)

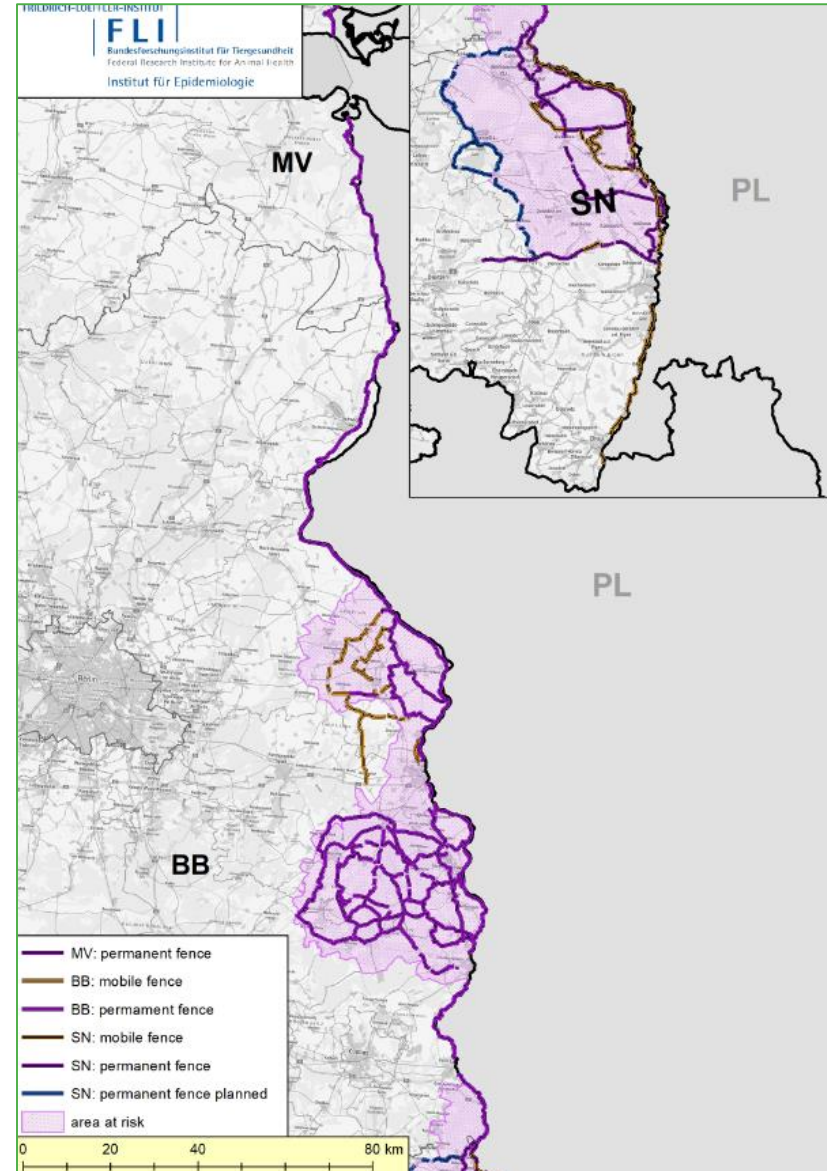
- **Saxony**

Border: 60 km permanent fence

Total: 150 km permanent fence

- **Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania**

Total/Border: 63 km permanent fence



ASF: Measures II

Fences

- **Brandenburg**

Border: 240 km (15 km left due to flooding)

Total:

532 km permanent fence

+ 117 km electric/site fence

= 649 km fences (yet)

- **Saxony**

Border: 60 km permanent fence

Total: 150 km permanent fence

- **Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania**

Total/Border: 63 km permanent fence
