



- 10% of all movements of animals within the EU
- Two main exit points
- Increasing trend








STARTING POINT - 2016

- Complaints from NGOs during the summer concerning exports by road to Turkey
- Do the NGOs have a point?
- Which Member States should we visit?






FIRST YEAR

2017:

- 12 Member States sent 1,696 consignments by road to Turkey in Jun-Aug
- More complaints from NGOs during the summer re. exports by road to Turkey







APPROVAL OF VEHICLES

- Partitions
- Ventilation
- Area per deck

- <u>Drinkers</u>

Ventilation, not air cooling systems



Temperature inside depends on temperature outside







OFFICIAL CONTROLS

 17 Member States have guidelines/instructions to check expected temperatures at the exit point (as on September 2019)

High temperatures are a major risk for AW

Booking at control posts — in TRACES

INSTRUCTIONS NOT FOLLOWED

No overview of what's done at local level







CONCLUSIONS

- Discrepancy official data and NGO reports
- "Bad" transporters and "bad" Member States
- Difficult to know what are the noncompliances — 'Other'

RETROSPECTIVE CHECKS

- Temperature records
- Data from Satellite Navigation Systems
- Tachographs

Big differences in quality and quantity
No clear instructions in most cases
Non-EU part of the journey: no data

Conclusions



BG-TR BORDER

- Very busy
- No animal facilities
- 6h to clear the Turkish side of the border
- Restricted opening times (improved!)
- Most 'further delays' due to 'bad' documents (identification/zootechnics) – animals blocked for days, weeks, months...
- Good practice by some transporters to clear the border as early as possible

- Many CAs have instructions to check temperature forecasts at the border
- Possibility to extend opening times on Turkish side of the border
- 9 Member States (down from 12) sent 512 consignments (70% less) by road to Turkey in Jun-Aug 2019
- Only one NGO report for summer 2019 very small number of non-compliant vehicles
