Slovenia's annual report for 2013 on the inspections of animals, means of transport and accompanying documents,

pursuant to art. 27 of the Regulation 1/2005/EC

We are sending you the annual report as required in article 27 of Regulation 1/2005/EC.

Analysis:

Total number of transported animals in Slovenia in 2013 is within the trend of previous years. The increase in total number of pigs and transported, which we observed in 2012, has in 2013 returned to numbers, comparable to the ones before 2012.

Total number of inspections increased in 2013. This is due to the increase of inspections on places of destination, while the number of road-side checks further decreased, similar to 2012.

Line (d) includes animals in transit through Slovenia. Information on this figure comes exclusively from TRACES database, which is not a reliable source of this information, as entering transit member states is not mandatory when completing Traces certificate.

Introduction of the new system of data collection for annual report, which was in action plan for 2013 is not completed yet. Further actions are needed to completely implement new data collection format.

Action plan:

Further actions for implementation of new format of data collection will be performed. Staff involved in reporting will be briefed and trained.
