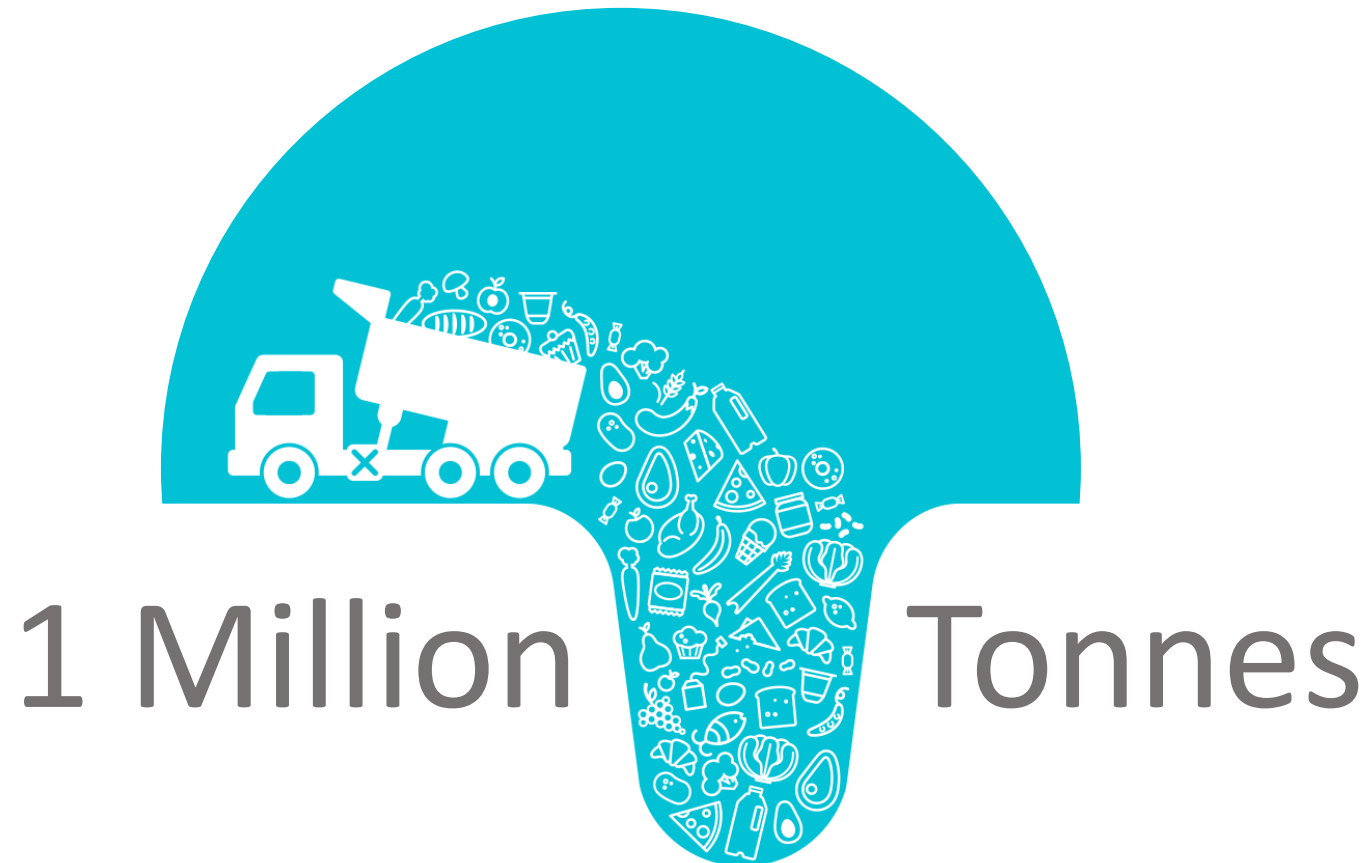

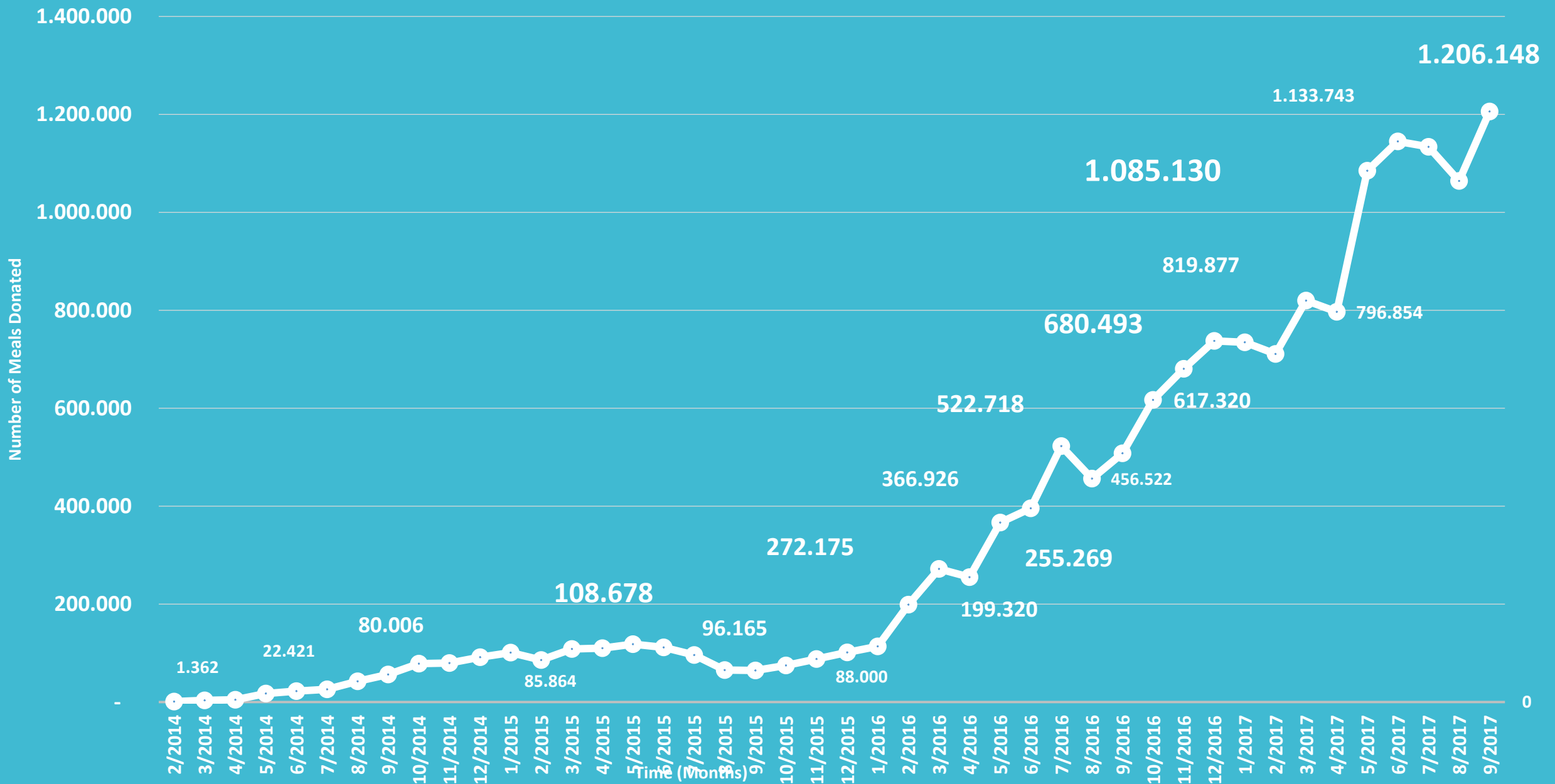

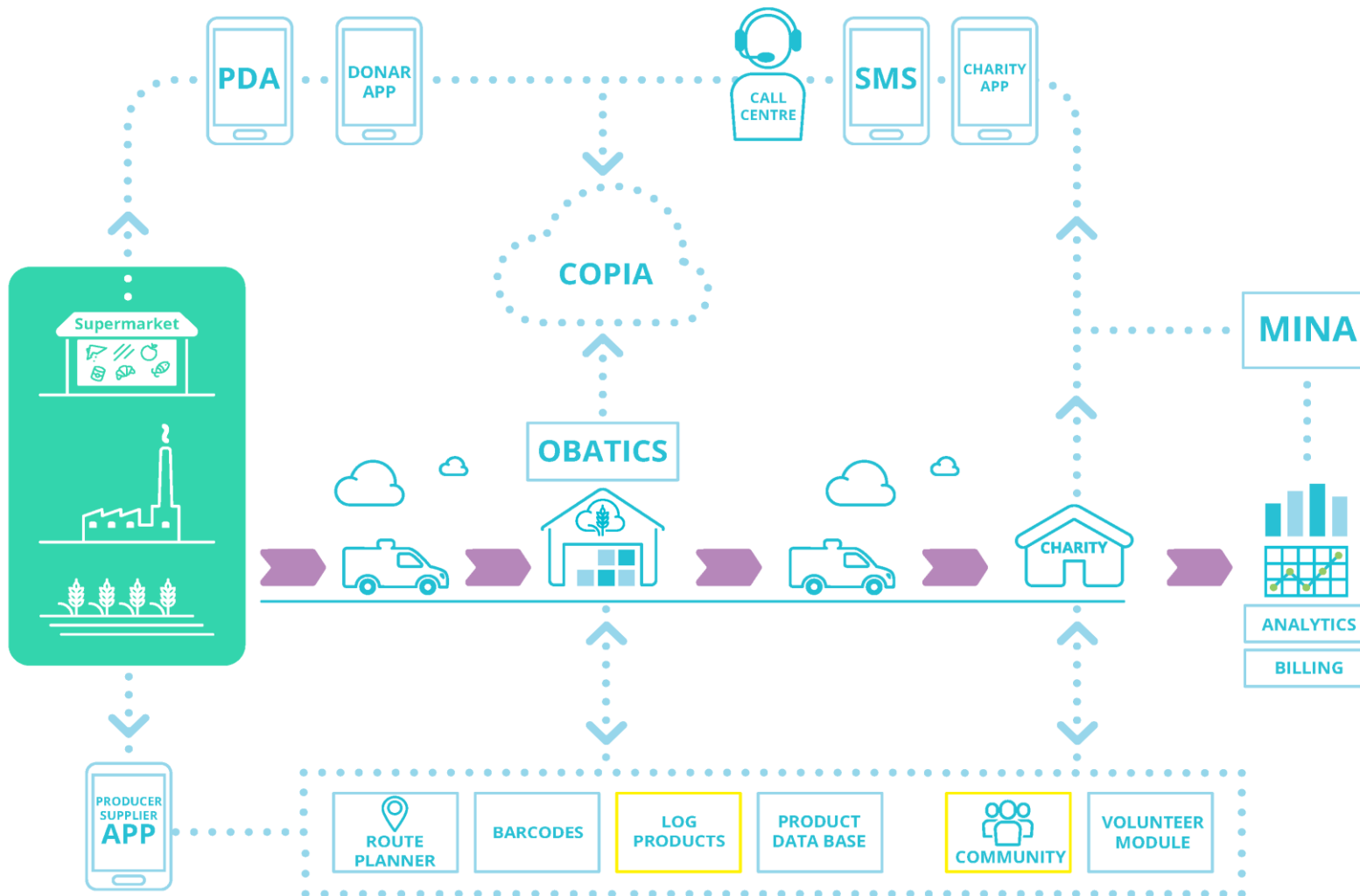

FEAD Phased Approach and Impact



				
PILOT PHASE (June – September 2016)	c.€200,000	10	c.13,000 individuals	59 tonnes
PHASE I (November 2016 – December 2017)	€3m	123	c.60,000 individuals in Q1	598 tonnes to Aug 2017
PHASE II (January 2018 – December 2020)	€12-13m	To expand to 140-150

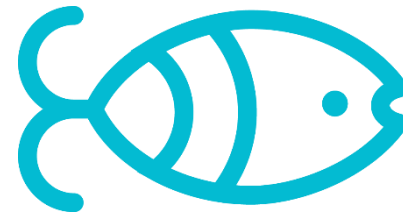

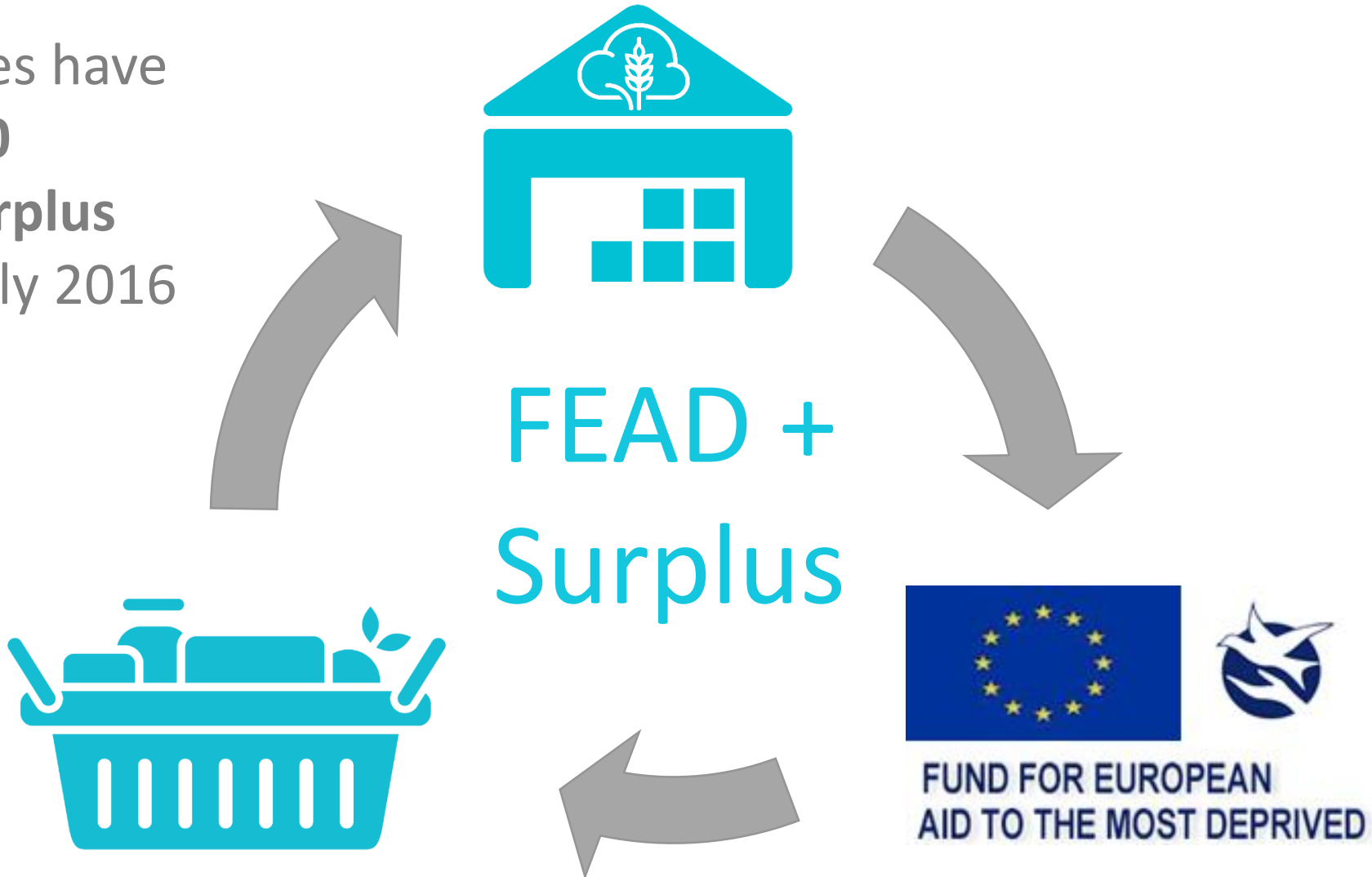
